Gordon R McInally

R. Gordon R. McInally is president-elect of Rotary International. He was educated at the Royal High School in Edinburgh and at the University of Dundee, where he earned his graduate degree in dental surgery. He operated his own dental practice in Edinburgh until 2016. Gordon was chair of the East of Scotland branch of the British Paedodontic Society and has held various academic positions. He has also served as a presbytery elder, chair of the Queensferry parish congregational board, and commissioner to the general assembly of the Church of Scotland.

Gordon joined Rotary in 1984 at age 26. A member of the Rotary Club of South Queensferry, he has served as president and vice president of Rotary International in Great Britain and Ireland (RIBI). He has also served RI as a director and on several committees, including as an adviser to the 2022 Houston Convention Committee and chair of the Operations Review Committee.

Gordon says he looks forward to working with members to build new Rotary clubs and groups. "My vision is that Rotary should exist everywhere in a style to suit everyone who has the desire to



be part of us and to help us do good in the world," he says.

Gordon is a patron of the UK-based nonprofit Hope and Homes for Children and led a partnership between that organization and RIBI to support children in Rwanda who had been orphaned in the genocide there. He is a patron of Trade-Aid, an initiative of the Rotary Club

of Grantham Kesteven, Lincolnshire, England, that provides sustainable humanitarian aid to individuals, families, and businesses in the developing world. He is also an ambassador for Bipolar UK, a national mental health organization.

In his free time, Gordon enjoys rugby, good food and wine, and stick dressing, the traditional Scottish craft of making walking sticks.

Gordon describes The Rotary Foundation as "the fuel that provides the energy to do Rotary service." He and his spouse, Heather, also a Rotarian, are Paul Harris Fellows, Major Donors, and Benefactors of The Rotary Foundation. They are also members of the Bequest Society.

Gordon wishes to dedicate his presidency to making the world a better place for his granddaughters, Ivy and Florence, to live and thrive.

Know your District Governor Hira Lal Yadav



Hiralal Yadav joined Rotary Club of Hooghly in the year 1995. He served as the President of the Rotary Club of Hooghly in the year 1998-1999 & 1999-2000. He is a past Rotaractor. He graduated from Calcutta University. He is a Ply Wood Manufacturer.

He revived the sick club which was recommended to be closed by the then District Governor. He established Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital in the year 2000 with only eight members in a rented building. The Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital became so popular, that a more spacious building was required. He constructed a well-designed 3 storied building for Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital in the year 2013. Now, Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital is a complete Eye Care Centre and pride of Rotary District 3291. In the last two decades he has

helped eighteen clubs in India and two clubs in Bangladesh to establish Eye Hospitals. He is the Chairman of Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital, Rotary Gangadharpur Eye Hospital & Kuchaikot Rotary Eye Hospital-Bihar. He is also the Chief advisor/ Technical Advisor of 17 Rotary Eye Hospitals.

Presently 55000-60000 surgeries are being done in these Eye Hospitals & 4 lakhs to 4.50 lakhs patients are being treated in the OPD & in Out Reach camps. His dream is to arrange Eye Check-up for 10 lac patients & eye surgeries for 1 lakh patients.

He has served Rotary District 3291 in different capacities and was invited as Guest Speaker in the Training Sessions and Conferences of Rotary District 3250 & 3291.

He is a great supporter of "The Rotary Foundation" & was instrumental in successfully completing 82 Global Grant Projects for different Rotary Clubs in India, Bangladesh, Singapore & UK. He had made arrangements to construct many tube-wells to provide safe drinking water in the remote villages of Hooghly. He also gave new life to 27 needy children by arranging Heart Surgeries in R.N. Tagore Heart Research - Kolkata & at Narayana Hrudyalaya - Bangalore. He was instrumental in setting up a Primary School at Hooghly Railway station for Underprivileged children in the year 2014. He also supports an orphanage - "Vivekananda Ashram" for the last 23 years. He has worked with District Administration of Hooghly in the implementation of Central Government Development Schemes as Nominated Member of the District Vigilance & Monitoring Committee 2012 to 2019.

He is a Major Donor and recipient of the highest Award of the Rotary International - "Service Above Self Award".

He is married to Deepali. She is an active member of Rotary Club of Hooghly.

About Us Rotary Central Calcutta

Rotary Club of Central Calcutta (RCCC) of Rotary International District 3291, was chartered in August 1984. The club has sponsored one Interact Club, two Rotaract Clubs and nine Rotary Community Corps (RCC) situated in Hooghly & South 24 Parganas. The Club is proud to have a full cricket team through International Fellowship of Cricket loving Rotarians (IFCR) and a very active & supportive Inner Wheel Club.

During the past 39 years, the club has initiated several rural village development activities, towards Swanirbharta (Self Reliance) through the RCCs. Several villages have been fully sanitized and have also been provided with safe drinking water. Vocational Training Centers have been set up towards self-employment. The club every year distributes blankets, mosquito nets, agricultural tools & equipment and thousands of fruit tree saplings, which improve the environment, provide nutritious food and more importantly are a source of income, especially for the women folk. Primary schools and education & training in modern methods of agriculture, pisciculture, poultry & animal husbandry is a regular feature. The club promotes Rotary's Blindness Prevention projects by providing Light to hundreds every year through IOL cataract surgeries. The club through its RCC-Human Development Centre, has spon-

sored an eye hospital at Joynagar with over 5000 cataract surgeries every year.

RCCC is closely associated with Vishudhanand Hospital, Marwari Relief Society, Premanand Memorial Leprosy Hospital, East Kolkata Nagarik Foundation & Shree Jain Hospital for several projects, including IOL cataract surgeries, providing artificial limbs, providing medical equipment including Dialysis machines, Ventilators & several wards in above hospitals have been done. The pride project of the Club is Rotary Siksha Kendra, a school in Village Bishnupur, Dist South 24 Parganas. The school has over 450 rural based children. It has its own two storied building with ten fully furnished rooms. Recently, the club has setup its own Dialysis Centre at Lake Town which will be managed by East Kolkata Nagarik Foundation.

All the activities of the Club have been possible because of the benevolent members and Internationality of Rotary with the magic of The Rotary Foundation-Grants Programs. The Club has forged wonderful and lasting relationships with friendly Rotarians & Clubs in Canada- RID 7010, 7070 & 5360, USA – RID 5790, 6440, 6380, 7410, 7470 & 7890, UK – RID 1070, 1090, 1110, 1120 & 1250, Australia RID 9640 and New Zealand RID 9940.

HISTORY OF ROTARY



Founder of Rotary Paul P Harris, a lawyer, was the founder of and visionary behind Rotary, the world's first international service club.

1905: Chicago attorney Paul P. Harris convenes the first Rotary meeting on 23rd February, with three other businessmen: Silvester Schiele, a coal merchant; Gustavus Loehr, a mining engineer; and Hiram Shorey, a merchant tailor.

9th March 1905: Second Meeting - Creation of the 'name badge' version of Rotary 'wheel' by Harry Ruggles who was a printer.

23rd March 1905: Silvester Schiele was chosen the 1st President in Rotary.

1907: The Rotary Club Of Chicago calls a meeting of civic organizations to establish a committee for installing city comfort stations or public toilets to improve sanitation.

1908: The Rotary Club Of San Francisco receives its charter on 12th November. Founding members Homer Wood, Chester H. Woolsey

and Roy r. Rogers attend the charter banquet. Club members elect Wood President and He becomes known as the Father of Rotary on the Pacific Coast.

1909: By 1909, seven clubs organized in Oakland, Seattle, Los Angeles, New York City and Boston

1910: The National Association of Rotary Clubs of America holds its first convention in Chicago, 15-17 August. Paul Harris is elected President of the association. Rotary comprises 16 clubs with over 1000 members throughout the United States.

1911: Rotary launches The National Rotarian (later The Rotarian) with Chesley Perry as editor. The 12 page periodical includes an essay written by Paul Harris about the purpose of Rotary clubs, announcements of newly chartered clubs and other club news items.

1912: The Rotary Club of Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada receives its charter on 13 April. The Rotary Club of London is the first European club to be chartered. Rotary changes its name to the International Association of Rotary Clubs to reflect its new membership.

1914: Rotary clubs in Great Britain and Ireland form the British Association of Rotary Clubs

1917: RI President Arch C Klumph proposes an endowment fund “for the purpose of doing good in the world”. The fund is the precursor to The Rotary Foundation, a not-for-profit philanthropic corporation that supports Rotary International.

1920: First Rotary Club formed in India - Rotary Club of Calcutta (1st January)

1922: Rotary International becomes the official name of Rotary. The name is approved as part of the new constitution and bylaws adopted at the international convention.

1924: The Board of Directors votes to adopt the modern Rotary emblem, 24 cogs and six pokes, a new version of the gearwheel first adopted in 1918. The redesigned logo has a more realistic gearwheel with a keyway added to signify usefulness.

1930: Rotary celebrates its 25th anniversary with the Silver Jubilee Convention in Chicago, 23-27 June

1940: World War II tests Rotary’s hope for peace. Rotarians establish the Rotary Relief Fund to help war victims. They draft a resolution calling for “respect for human rights”. This set the stage for Rotary’s prominent role in promoting world peace.

1943: RI officially adopts The Four Way Test, one of the world’s most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics. Herbert J. Taylor , RI President 1954-55 , drafted the 24 word test in 1932.

1945: A group of 49 Rotarians help draft the United Nations Charter. RI is granted adviser status at the UN Charter Conference. This set the stage for future partnerships with UN agencies.

1947: Rotary founder Paul Harris dies on 27th January. AN outpouring of contributions to the Rotary Foundation creates the Paul Harris Memorial Fund.

1950: Rotary formally approves two official mottoes at the RI Convention in Detroit, Michigan, USA - Service Above Self & He Profits Most Who Serves Best.

1955: Rotary celebrates its golden anniversary with 8500 clubs in 89 countries at the RI Convention held in Chicago.

1957: The Rotary Foundation creates Paul Harris Fellow Recognition and other awards for donors to Foundation Programs.

1962: The first Interact Club - a youth program for service and international fellowship, is formed in Melbourne, Florida, USA.

1968: The RI Board approves Rotaract ('Rotary in Action'), a program for young adults older than interact age to participate in service and fellowship.

1970: The Council on Legislation becomes the official law making body of Rotary.

1985: Rotary launches Polio Plus to fund the operational, social mobilization and training efforts required to eradicate polio.

1987: Women join Rotary.

1989: The Council on Legislation votes to eliminate the requirement that club membership be limited to males, permitting clubs worldwide to admit women.

2002: Europe is declared polio-free at the RI Convention in Barcelona, Spain.

1989-2005: Rotary came close to removing polio from the face of the Earth.

2005: Rotary celebrates its 100th anniversary at the centennial convention in Chicago.

2014: 27th March Indian subcontinent declared polio free.

2019: 3rd January – celebration of 100 years of Rotary in India.

2020: 100th Year of Rotary in India.

2021: In response to COVID-19 pandemic, RI mobilized its global network to support vaccination efforts, provide medical equipment and offer humanitarian aid.

2022: Rotary celebrated the 100th anniversary of its first international convention held in Edinburgh in 1922. This was celebrated with various events worldwide, highlighting Rotary's century-long commitment to service, fellowship and international cooperation.

Harris envisioned a professional club that brings together men from a variety of vocations. **Paul Harris named the new club “Rotary”** because members met in rotation at their various places of business.

Rotary's Seven Areas of Focus



Basic Education and Literacy

More than 775 million people over the age of 15 are illiterate. Our goal is to strengthen the capacity of communities to support basic education and literacy, reduce gender disparity in education, and increase adult literacy.

Maternal and Child Health

Nearly 6 million children under the age of five die each year because of malnutrition, poor health care, and inadequate sanitation. We expand access to quality care, so mothers and their children can live and grow stronger.

Peace and Conflict Prevention / Resolution

Rotary encourages conversations to foster understanding within and across cultures. We train adults and young leaders to prevent and mediate conflict and help refugees who have fled dangerous areas.

Disease Prevention and Treatment

We educate and equip communities to stop the spread of life-threatening diseases like polio, HIV/AIDS, and malaria. We improve and expand access to low-cost and free health care in developing areas.

Water, Sanitation & Hygiene

We support local solutions to bring clean water, sanitation, and hygiene to more people every day. We don't just build wells and walk away. We share our expertise with community leaders and educators to make sure our projects succeed long-term.

Community and Economic Development

We carry out service projects that enhance economic and community development and create opportunities for decent and productive work for young and old. We also strengthen local entrepreneurs and community leaders, particularly women, in impoverished communities.

Support the Environment

Rotary's newest area of focus is the environment which will enable Rotarians and Rotary Clubs to bring about positive change in the world and increase our impact.

Rotary's Guiding Principles

Basic principles that guide Rotarians in achieving the ideals of service and high ethical standards.

■ First Guiding Principle

Object of Rotary: First formulated in 1910, the Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideals of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and in particular, to encourage and foster:

First: The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;

Second: High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

Third: The application of the ideals of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life;

Fourth: The advancement of International understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

■ Second Guiding Principle

Classification: Classification is based on the founder's paradigm of choosing cross-representation of each business, profession, and institution within a community.

■ Third Guiding Principle

Avenues of Service: The Avenues of Service, based on the Object of Rotary, are Rotary's philosophical cornerstones and the foundation on which club activity is based. There are five Avenues of Service:

First Avenue of Service **CLUB SERVICE**

Second Avenue of Service **VOCATIONAL SERVICE**

Third Avenue of Service **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

Fourth Avenue of Service **INTERNATIONAL SERVICE**

Fifth Avenue of Service **YOUTH SERVICE**

20 Reasons to be a Rotarian:

From Richard D. King, RI President 2001-02

- 1. Friendship:** In an increasingly complex world, Rotary provides one of the most basic human needs: the need for friendship and fellowship. It is one of two reasons why Rotary began in 1905.
- 2. Business Development:** The second original reason for Rotary's beginning is business development. Everyone needs to network. Rotary consists of a cross section of every business community. Its members come from all walks of life. Rotarians help each other and collectively help others.
- 3. Personal Growth and Development:** Membership in Rotary continues one's growth and education in human relations and personal development.
- 4. Leadership Development:** Rotary is an organization of leaders and successful people. Serving in Rotary positions is like a college education. Leadership: - learning how to motivate, influence, and lead leaders.
- 5. Citizenship in the Community:** Membership in a Rotary club makes one a better community citizen. The average Rotary club consists of the most active citizens of any community.
- 6. Continuing Education:** Each week at Rotary there is a program designed to keep one informed about what is going on in the community, nation, and world. Each meeting provides an opportunity to listen to different speakers and a variety of timely topics.
- 7. Fun:** Rotary is fun, a lot of fun. Each meeting is fun. The club projects are fun. Social activities are fun. The service is fun.
- 8. Public Speaking Skills:** Many individuals who joined Rotary were afraid to speak in public. Rotary develops confidence and skill in public communication and the opportunity to practice and perfect these skills.
- 9. Citizenship in the World:** Every Rotarian wears a pin that says "Rotary International." There are few places on the globe that do not have a Rotary club. Every Rotarian is welcome – even encouraged – to attend any of the 29,000 clubs in 194 nations and geographical regions. This means instant friends in both one's own community and in the world community.
- 10. Assistance when Traveling:** Because there are Rotary clubs everywhere, many a Rotarian in need of a doctor, lawyer, hotel, dentist, advice, etc., while traveling has found assistance through Rotary.

11. Entertainment: Every Rotary club and district has parties and activities that provide diversion in one's business life. Rotary holds conferences, conventions, assemblies, and institutes that provide entertainment in addition to Rotary information, education, and service.

12. The Development of Social Skills: Every week and at various events and functions, Rotary develops one's personality, social skills and people skills. Rotary is for people who like people.

13. Family Programs: Rotary provides one of the world's largest youth exchange programs; high school and college clubs for future Rotarians; opportunities for spouse involvement; and a host of activities designed to help family members in growth and the development of family values.

14. Vocational Skills: Every Rotarian is expected to take part in the growth and development of his or her own profession or vocation; to serve on committees and to teach youth about one's job or vocation. Rotary helps to make one a better doctor, lawyer, teacher, etc...

15. The Development of Ethics: Rotarians practice a 4-Way Test that governs one's ethical standards. Rotarians are expected to be ethical in business and personal relationships.

16. Cultural Awareness: Around the world, practically every religion, country, culture, race, creed, political persuasion, language, color, and ethnic identity is found in Rotary. It is a cross section of the world's most prominent citizens from every background. Rotarians become aware of their cultures and learn to love and work with people everywhere. They become better citizens of their countries in the process.

17. Prestige: Rotary members are prominent people: leaders of business, the professions, art, government, sports, military, religion, and all disciplines. Rotary is the oldest and most prestigious service club in the world. Its ranks include executives, managers, professionals – people who make decisions and influence policy.

18. Nice People: Rotarians above all are nice people - the nicest people on the face of the earth. They are important people who follow the policy of it is nice to be important but it is important to be nice.

19. The Absence of an "Official Creed": Rotary has no secret handshake, no secret policy, no official creed, no secret meeting or rituals. It is an open society of men and women who simply believe in helping others.

20. The Opportunity to Serve: Rotary is a service club. Its business is mankind. Its product is service. Rotarians provide community service to both local and international communities. This is perhaps the best reason for becoming a Rotarian: the chance to do something for somebody else and to sense the self-fulfillment that comes in the process and return of that satisfaction to one's own life. It is richly rewarding
