- 1. Jaipur Foot & Kalbagh Shelter house for the mentally challenged in Vile Parle, East.
- 2. The first matching grant received by RCBA was used to supply water to Pissai village in Maharashtra.
- 3. A project fundraising program was held with the Ghazhal Maestro, the Late Jagjit Singh at Elephanta Caves.
- 4. An Ashramshala was constructed at Maswan. Additionally, at the Ganjad Ashramshala, girls' & boys' hostels, along with toilets & a kitchen with high-tech steamers & a dining hall. A Boys' hostel & classrooms have been constructed in the Ranshet Ashramshala. These three schools, together, have over 2.000 beneficiaries.
- 5. A skill development programme for the transgender's was conducted, empowering them to get employment in well-known companies.
- 6. A Dialysis Centre, with high-tech machines, has been established by RCBA near Vile Parle station. Numerous patients are regularly benefitting from the facilities here.
- 7. GIFT OF LIFE Paediatric Heart surgeries, are being carried out

- for the past 4 years at Shri Satya Sai hospital khargar. Over 470 children have been treated with a cumulative amount of 6.60 crores.
- 8. RCBA has renovated four operation theatres at the Brahmakumaris Global Hospital.
- 9. The Thalassemia daycare Centre at Somaiyya College Hospital was refurbished & ambulances & multi-utility vehicles were donated to various other hospitals.
- 10. Mega blood donation camps are held regularly, collecting thousands of bottles every year.
- 11. Regular Eye, Dental & other health check-up camps for diabetes, blood pressure, etc., are set up regularly, for the underprivileged, at various sites helping hundreds of people every year.
- 12. A Cancer Screening & health check-up camp is organised at CINTAA(Cine & TV Artist Association) annually.
- 13. RCBA has installed 12 AED machines at various railway stations & other such places with high footfall. Additionally, CPR(Cardiopulmonary resuscitation) training has been imparted to a large number of people.
- 14. Mental Wellness camps are organised for our interactors regularly and a

16. RCBA has been organizing a high-octane Public Image Project, 'Juhu Half Marathon' (JHM) for the last six years involving 20,000 runners. The surplus collections are used for Paediatric heart surgeries for those
