18 Classrooms were constructed at Ranshet Ashramshala

- 1. Jaipur Foot & Kalbagh Shelter house for the mentally challenged at Vile
- 2. First matching grant received by RCBA was used to supply water to Pissai village in Maharashtra.
- 3. A Fund Raising Programme for projects was held with the Ghazhal Maestro Late Jagjit Singh at Elephanta Caves.
- 4. An Ashramshala is constructed at Maswan. At Ganjad ashram shala, girls & boys hostels have been constructed along with toilets & also kitchen with high tech steamers & dining hall.
 - In Ranshet ashramshala, boys hostel \$ classrooms have been constructed. These three schools have more than 2000 beneficiaries.
- 5. Skill Development Programme for the transgenders was conducted which empowered them to get employment in well known companies.
- 6. A Dialysis Center has been established by RCBA with high tech machines nearVile Parle station where patients are regularly availing the facility.

- 7. GIFT OF LIFE, Paediatric Heart Surgery at Shri Satya Sai hospital khargar, is being done since last five years benefitting over 630 children with cumulative amount of US\$1.12 Million (INR9.63 crores).
- 8. RCBA has renovated four operation theatres at the Brahmakumaris global hospital.
- 9. The Thalassemia day care centre at Somaiyya college hospital was refurbished & ambulances & multi utility vehicles have also been donated to various hospitals.
- 10. Mega blood donation camps are held regularly collecting thousands of bottles every year.
- 11. Regular Eye check up camps, Dental check up & other health check up camps for diabetes, blood pressure & other things are conducted regularly for the underprivileged at various places helping hundreds of people every year.
- 12. Cancer Screening & health check up camp is held at CINTAA (Cine & TV Artist Association) every year.
- 13. RCBA has installed more than 50 AED machines at various railway stations & other places. CPR (Cardiopulmonary resuscitation) training has been given to a large number of people.
- 14. Mental Wellness camps are held for our interactors regularly. A Special Education Programme (SPed) was held for 35 children with slow learning disabilities.

- 15. Suicide Prevention Camp was conducted with the support of renowned Psychiatrist Dr. Anjali Chabbria, where around 4000 college children attended during the year.
- 16. RCBA has been organising the high octane Public Image Project, 'Juhu Half Marathon' (JHM) from the last seven years involving around 25,000 runners & the surplus is used for paediatric heart surgery.
- 17. A magnificent Covid Warrior Structure with RCBA brand was created & placed in a very prominent square of Bandra West, thus enhancing our club image.
- 18. A large number of fruit & vegetable tree saplings are donated periodically to the villagers for their economic upliftment. Tree plantations are done routinely. Miyawaki forests were also created.
- 19. We have hosted 5 DTA (District Training Assembly) & have formed 4 new
- 20. 25,500 notebooks branded by RCBA were distributed to the underprivileged children.
