Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) is a leadership program coordinated by Rotary Clubs around the globe. Each year, thousands of young people are chosen to participate in this program. Young people ages 14-30 are sponsored by Rotary Clubs to attend the event run by the club's district committee. Participants are chosen for their leadership potential. Rotary Clubs and the Rotary District cover all expenses for the participants. The format of the event vary from district to district, but commonly take the form of a seminar, camp, or workshop to discuss leadership skills and to learn those skills through practice. Rotary clubs and districts select participants and facilitate the event's curriculum.

Rotary Bangalore West started its own brand of RYLA program – called 'INTERMEET' during the year 1986-87 and has continued to hold this youth camp for nearly 36 years now.

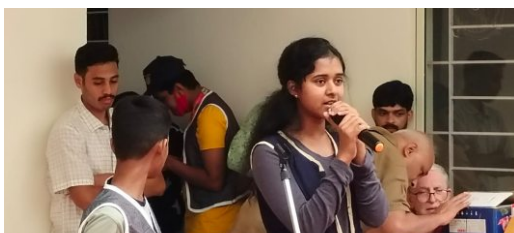

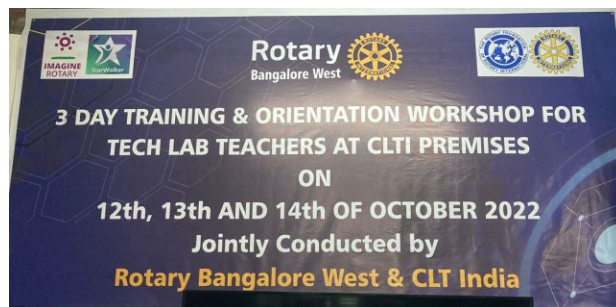


On the Occasion of World Food Day, a Food Drive was organized by Rotaract Bangalore West on 16th October 2022.

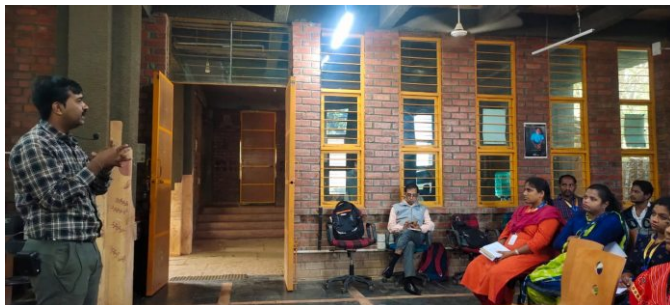
