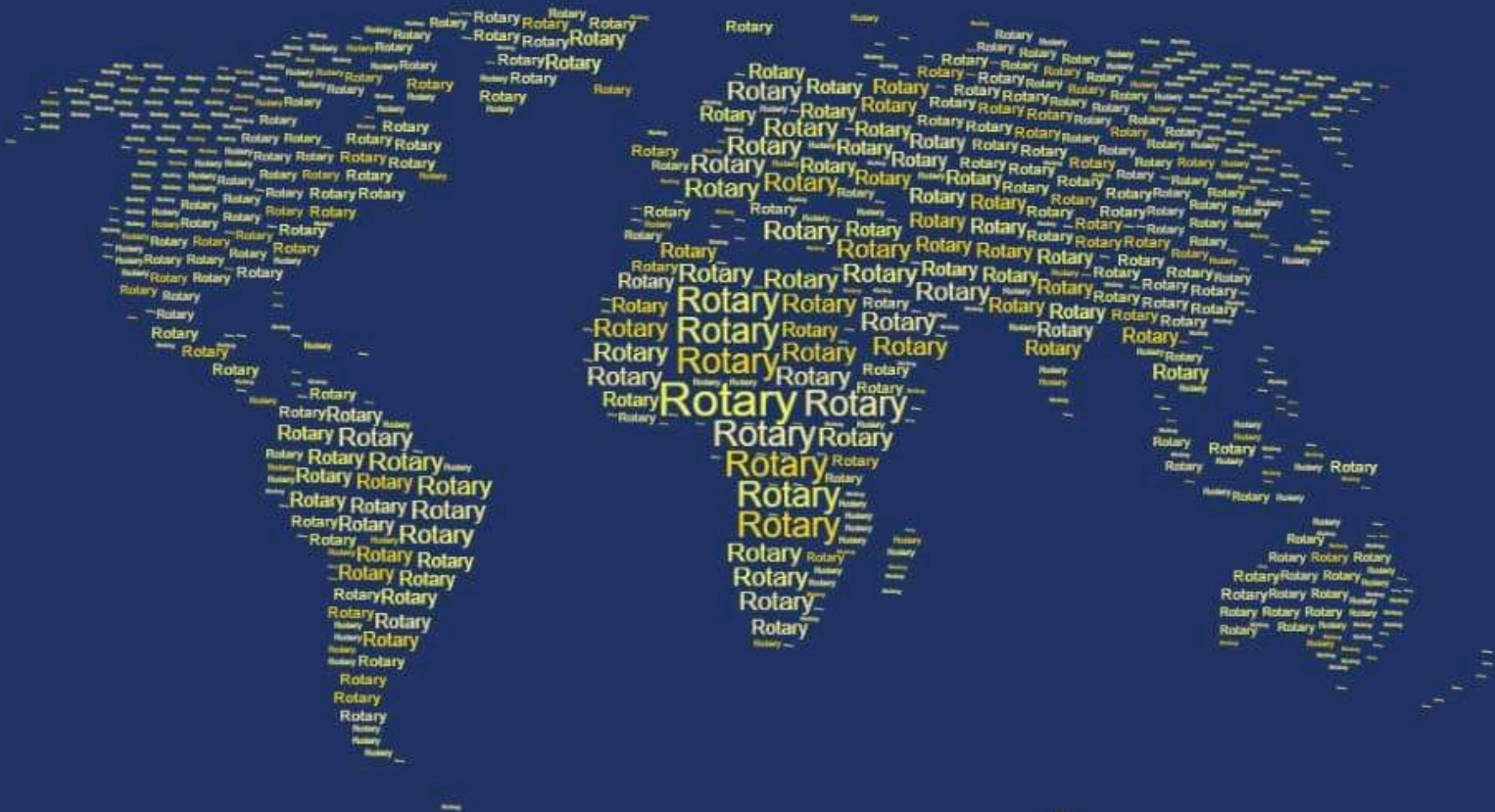

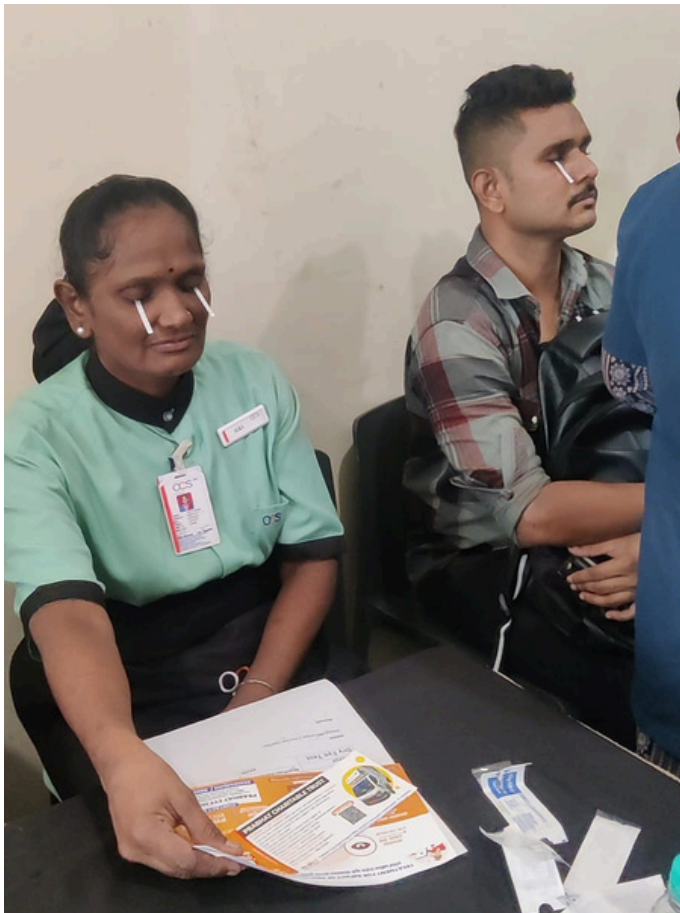

The foundation upon which Rotary is built is friendship; on no less firm foundation could it have stood.

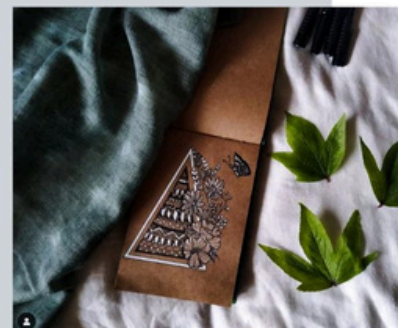
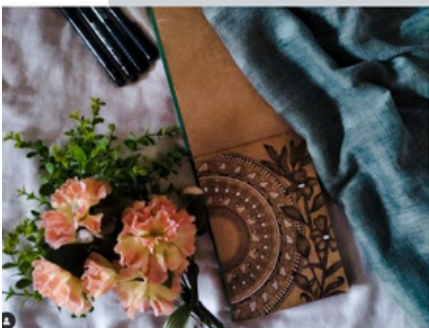
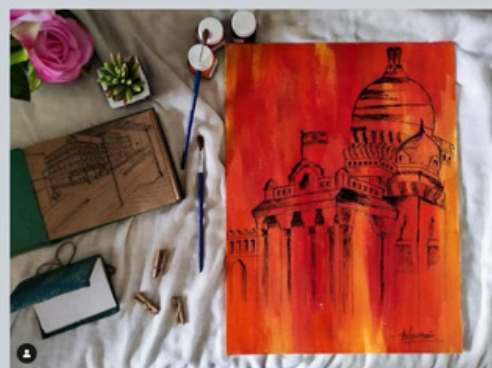
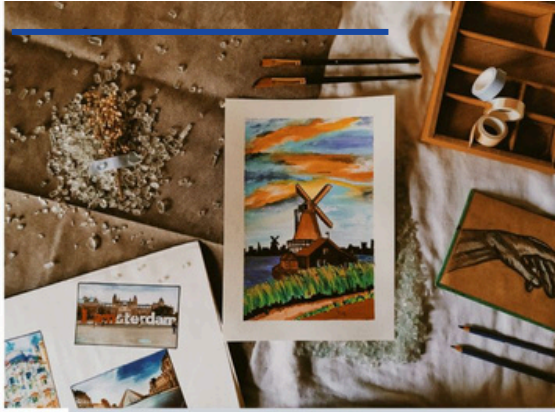
