We will miss him dearly! Every time the thought of service above self-crosses our minds, we will continue to think of Ratan Tata.




How do you pay tribute to a Titan of Industry, who has exhibited Steely resolve and motored beyond obstacles to give flight to all that the TATA name and group stands for.

Behind the Scenes of Successful Global Grants

Rotarians Share Their Secrets A Best Practices Analysis

This report analyzes key insights gleaned from Rotarians who spearheaded The Rotary Foundation's recently recognized exemplary global grant projects. These projects, celebrated for their sustainability, alignment with Rotary's focus areas, and community-driven approach, offer valuable best practices for future initiatives.

Building Strategic Partnerships for Effective Project Execution

The identification of a suitable partner club is crucial for successful project execution. Stephen Baker (Rotary Club of Key Biscayne, Florida) emphasizes the importance of face-to-face interaction in fostering effective collaboration, particularly for complex projects. John Braun (Rotary Club of Austin, Texas) suggests attending district conferences specifically designed to showcase projects and facilitate connections between clubs. Mario Nasard (Rotary Club of Baabda, Lebanon) highlights the valuable role past district governors can play in connecting clubs for potential partnerships. Patrick Biswas (Rotary Club of Padma Rajshahi, Bangladesh) recommends inviting Rotarians from other countries to experience the local community work, fostering understanding and potential partnerships. Gus Oppermann (Rotary Club of Los Angeles, California) emphasizes the value of attending Rotary conventions and project fairs, as well as utilizing online resources like Rotary Showcase and Rotary Ideas to connect with potential partners.

Conducting Thorough Community Needs Assessments

Effective projects necessitate a clear understanding of the community's needs. Carolina Barrios (Rotary Club of Cartagena de Indias, Colombia) highlights the involvement of the Rotary Community Corps (RCC) in identifying beneficiaries, coordinating construction, and promoting the program within the community. Steven Caine (Rotary Club of Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake, New York) advises conducting community assessments by collaborating with local service organizations. Pilot projects were also recommended by Stephen Baker (Rotary Club of Key Biscayne, Florida) as a way to validate the project concept and refine the approach before a full-scale global grant is pursued.

Lessons Learned and Recommendations for Future Projects

Rotarians also shared valuable lessons gleaned from their project experiences. Patrick Coleman (Rotary Club of Luanshya, Zambia) emphasizes the importance of thoroughly comprehending the technical aspects of the project beforehand. Julio Grazioso (Rotary Club of Guatemala Vista Hermosa, Guatemala) highlights the importance of strong partnerships and clear communication. Steven Caine (Rotary Club of Burnt Hills-Ballston Lake, New York)recommends establishing realistic timelines to account for project complexities. Vasudha Rajasekar (Rotary Club of Madras East, India) emphasizes thorough research on legal frameworks to avoid delays.

Considerations for Global Grant Champions


- Pilot Projects: Test ideas before full-scale implementation.
- Partnerships: Find the right club for shared goals.
- Community Needs: Understand local needs for sustainability.
- Timelines: Be prepared for delays.
- Communication: Keep everyone informed throughout the project.

The Power of Rotary Giving

Why give to The Rotary Foundation? Philip J. Silvers (District 5500, Arizona) emphasizes the unique advantage of having Rotarians in host countries to ensure proper utilization of funds. Additionally, the Foundation's Cadre of Technical Advisers provides invaluable support throughout the grant process.

Ultimately, Gus Oppermann (Rotary Club of Los Angeles, California) succinctly summarizes the essence of Rotary giving: "We, Rotarians, can't do the good we do globally unless we give to The Rotary Foundation!"
