He obtained a B.E. (Mechanical) from Pune. With such impressive credentials, he settled in Bhopal and pursued his career as a freelancer working as a freelance surveyor and loss assessor caused by accidents, fires, and engineering breakdowns.

In 1990, he launched Khurana Surgical & Marketing Pvt. Ltd, a firm specializing in surgical and physiotherapy items, operating multiple branches in India. He and his brother founded G.B. Multicare Hospital Pvt. Ltd, which expanded to 30 beds in 2012 and he served as Director until 2018 continues as key stakeholder.

Keen, a sportsman with a passion for golf and cricket, has traveled globally and made friends, while Ginny, the first lady of the district, is a lawyer by profession.

## DG की कहानी उन्हीं की जुबानी

### 1) An incident of your life which motivated you to join Rotary?

My journey with Rotary began with my father, a dedicated Rotarian also President of the Rotary Club of Nagpur East in 1971-72. He ingrained the values and mission of Rotary in me from a young age.

A pivotal moment in my Rotary journey occurred in 1998-99, when Dr. Manmohan Singh Luthra, a relative from Pittsburgh, USA, visited Nagpur for a Rotary project. Dr. Luthra, a Past Governor of Rotary District 7300, came to Nagpur to participate in an eye and plastic surgery camp in Kanhan. He stayed with us, and I had the privilege of accompanying him to the medical project for two to three days. His dedication and passion for Rotary's humanitarian efforts left a lasting impression on me. Before returning to the USA, my uncle encouraged me to join Rotary, aspire to become a Club President, and even aim for the position of District Governor.

My professional connection with Dr. Rajan further strengthened my ties to Rotary. Dr. Rajan frequently invited me to join the organization, and in April 2001, he extended an invitation to attend a meeting at the Rotary Club of Nagpur West. I attended several meetings and was inspired by the camaraderie and commitment of the members. Consequently, on July 17th, 2001, during Dr. K S Rajan's Presidential term, I was formally inducted into the club.

Rotary has been a significant part of my life, shaped by the influence of my father, the inspiring visit of Dr. Luthra, and the persistent encouragement from Dr. Rajan. These experiences have fueled my dedication to serving the community through Rotary.

### 2) In your Rotary career, you achieved a lot of honours, prestigious awards. Whether it was ur passion, ambition to achieve these awards or anything else

Rotary is an organization founded on the principles of selfless service, and my journey with Rotary has been driven by a deep commitment to these values. From the beginning, I have drawn inspiration from the exemplary

leadership of my club and district leaders. Their dedication has motivated me to give my 100% to every Rotary responsibility I have undertaken, approaching each task with unwavering dedication and integrity.

One of the core beliefs I hold is the importance of delegation and teamwork. In Rotary, as in any effective organization, success is achieved not through the efforts of a single individual, but through the collective contributions of a dedicated team. This philosophy has guided my approach to every project and initiative I have been a part of.

I have never sought awards or recognitions in my Rotary journey. These accolades are not something one aims for; rather, they are acknowledgments made by district leaders who observe the efforts and impacts of our work. When awards do come, they are not a reflection of individual achievement but a testament to the power of teamwork and collaboration. The true reward lies in the positive changes we bring to our communities and the lives we touch through our service.

### 3) How did you strike a balance within all spheres Rotary, occupation, family?

Balancing family, Rotary, professional commitments, and sports has been a fulfilling yet challenging journey. The cornerstone of my success in maintaining this balance has been the unwavering support of my family. Their encouragement and understanding have allowed me to dedicate time and effort to Rotary and professional responsibilities while still enjoying sports. Delegation and efficient time management have also played crucial roles. By prioritizing tasks and fostering teamwork, I ensure that each aspect of my life receives the attention it deserves. Ultimately, the harmony in my life stems from a supportive family and a commitment to balance and dedication in all endeavors.





**4) What made you choose an academic career over sports?**

I was always an avid sports enthusiast, representing my school in cricket, football, volleyball, table tennis, and athletics. In higher secondary school, I played for the Vidarbha Cricket team in the under-19 C K Naidu Trophy. Our coach from the Cricket Control Board of India saw potential in me and encouraged me to pursue cricket as a career. Supported by my father, I was ready to give it a shot. However, during a family trip to Kashmir, I missed the admission window for most professional colleges. I joined a local college on a sports quota but soon after, a freak accident resulted in a shoulder injury, limiting my sports activities. Subsequently, I moved to Pune for engineering studies, where I continued playing sports but ultimately chose a professional career due to my injury.

**5) Did you have support from your family for social activities or they always succumbed to their role...**

As mentioned earlier, my father was a dedicated Rotarian and my mother served as President of the Inner Wheel Club of Nagpur East in 1971-72. This ingrained a strong sense of social responsibility in me from a young age, making time for social activities and Rotary a natural part of my life. Fortunately, my wife shares this commitment to social causes and consistently supports and accompanies me in my endeavors. My daughters, who have been actively involved in Interact and Rotaract, are also socially conscious and fully back my initiatives. With such a supportive family, dedicating time to social activities and Rotary has never been an issue.

**6) How you broke your comfort zone to serve the society**

Everyone enjoys being in their comfort zone, but staying active in Rotary and social causes often requires significant sacrifices. Despite these challenges, if one truly enjoys and is passionate about their work, these sacrifices don't feel burdensome. My involvement in Rotary and social activities has required dedication and sometimes giving up personal time. However, with a genuine passion for making a difference and the unwavering support of my family, these sacrifices become manageable and fulfilling. When you love what you do, the joy and satisfaction of contributing to the community far outweigh any personal sacrifices.

Once projects are entered into Showcase, the achievements for the club's service project goals will appear in Rotary Club Central after 24 hours.
- Please note that the goal achievement is based on the project being marked as complete and the project end date determines the program year. For example, a service project with the end date 1 October 2023 will be counted for the 2023-2024 Rotary program year achievements in Rotary Club Central.
- **My Club Projects** - If you would like to view or search the service projects posted on Showcase by your club, click on My Club Projects at the top of the page.
- **Adding a project** - Any active Rotary or Rotaract member can post projects in Rotary Showcase.
- **Editing, copying, and deleting projects** - The member who posted the project, members added as project contacts, and the current club president can edit, copy, or delete a project.
- **Engagement tracker** - When you add an end date to your service project, an engagement tracker appears at the bottom of the page (part 7) where you can track the number of volunteers, volunteer hours, funds raised, etc.
