District Polio Seminar - Darpan

October 20, 2024 | Hotel Atithi, Muzaffarpur | Host - All Clubs of Muzaffarpur

On October 20, 2024, District 3250 held its Public Image cum End Polio Seminar in Muzaffarpur, hosted by all the local Rotary clubs. The seminar opened with the traditional lighting of the lamp and invocation led by District Governor (DG) and other dignitaries, symbolizing the hope and commitment to a polio-free world.

Distinguished Speakers and Key Messages

The seminar featured prominent speakers who shared their insights on polio eradication and the importance of Rotary's public image:

- Chief Guest and Keynote Speaker:** Past District Governor (PDG) Dr. Pramod Kumar captivated the audience with his address, titled "Jo Dikhata Hai Woh Bikta Hai". He emphasized the power of visibility and public image, encouraging Rotarians to showcase their efforts to attract support and recognition for Rotary's impactful work.
- Guest Speaker:** ARPIC PDG Pratim Banerjee, in his motivational talk, "Tu Bhi Rotary, Main Bhi Rotary," reinforced the idea of Rotary as a shared commitment, inviting all to engage actively in Rotary's causes, especially in the fight to end polio.
- Guest of Honor:** EPNC PDG Uttam Ganguly delivered an impactful presentation titled "Virus Abhi Zinda Hai" (The Virus is Still Alive). Through a detailed presentation, he highlighted the persistence of the polio virus and its devastating impact on children worldwide. PDG Ganguly underscored the importance of continued vigilance, donations to the Polio Fund, and the vital role of becoming Polio Society members to support eradication efforts.
- DPCC Kusum Thakur** addressed the audience with a powerful message, stressing the importance of not becoming complacent in this final phase of the fight against polio. She stated, "If we ignore working on 'End Polio Now' in this last lap, all the efforts we Rotarians have made will not be recognized." She emphasized the importance of awareness and called upon all district members to contribute to the Polio Fund.

In response to her appeal, 19 members came forward, each pledging \$100 and committing to join the Polio Society, further strengthening District 3250's commitment to Rotary's global polio eradication mission.

Attendance and Organization

The seminar was attended by approximately 250 delegates, reflecting strong engagement and solidarity within the district. The event was excellently organized, providing both inspiration and actionable insights for Rotarians to contribute to Rotary's vision of a polio-free world.

District 3250's Public Image cum End Polio Seminar not only highlighted the crucial work still needed in the fight against polio but also underscored Rotary's public image as a force for change, motivating members to champion this cause with renewed commitment and visibility.

On World Polio Day, October 24, 2024, Rotary clubs across District 3250 organized a variety of impactful activities aimed at raising awareness about polio eradication and reinforcing Rotary's commitment to ending polio globally. The following highlights demonstrate the diverse efforts by clubs in the district to engage communities, educate the public, and encourage vaccination.

1. **RC Amrapali Muz:** Led a Polio Awareness Rally in Muzaffarpur in collaboration with other local Rotary clubs to promote polio prevention and vaccination.
2. **RC Arrah:** Hosted a seminar titled "End Polio Now" at Surya Clinic, educating attendees on the importance of immunization.

Weaving Magic Locally

AMRAPALI MUZAFFARPUR

On Polio Awareness Day, all Rotary clubs of Muzaffarpur came together to organize a Polio Awareness Rally aimed at spreading the message of polio prevention and the importance of vaccination. This rally was a collective effort to reinforce Rotary's commitment to the End Polio Now campaign and educate the public about the dangers of polio and the need for immunization.



ARRAH

On Polio Awareness Day, a seminar titled "End Polio Now" was conducted at Surya Clinic with the goal of raising awareness about polio eradication and the importance of vaccination. This event was organized as part of Rotary's ongoing efforts to educate the public on polio prevention and emphasize the critical need for immunization.



BETTIAH CENTRAL

The Rotary Club of Bettiah central conducted several impactful activities, including a cleanliness drive and donation of sports items at Rajkiye Krit Uttkramit Madhya Vidyalay in Khasuar. They vaccinated street dogs in Ranipur Village on World Rabies Day and distributed food packets to flood-affected families in Lauria Block. Four girls received their second dose of the cervical cancer vaccine at Rtn Dr. Pradeep Kumar's clinic, and Rtn Dr. Umesh Kumar provided health check-ups for 50 people on National Arthritis Day. A CPR awareness camp was held for teachers at St. Xavier Higher Secondary School. Members attended a district seminar on public image and polio, organized a Polio Awareness Rally in Khasuar Village, and celebrated Hand Wash Day at their adopted school, distributing soap and teaching hygiene practices. Finally, members celebrated a Pre-Diwali meet with fireworks and dinner at Rtn Dr. Pradeep Kumar's residence.



BHAGALPUR

Several humanitarian initiatives were recently carried out by RC Bhagalpur, focusing on health and support for those in need. Food packets were distributed to flood victims, and comprehensive health check-ups, including dental examinations, were conducted for flood survivors to address their immediate health concerns. A "Know Your Number" health check-up camp was held at Sushila Hospital to raise awareness about essential health metrics. Additionally, a Breast Cancer Detection Camp took place at Sushila Hospital in Bhagalpur to promote early detection and awareness. Finally, a Pulse Polio campaign was organized from Nihar Hotel, contributing to the ongoing efforts to eradicate polio in the region.

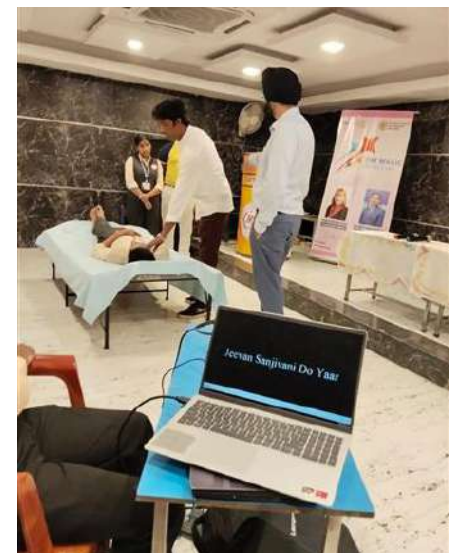
JAMSHEDPUR GREEN

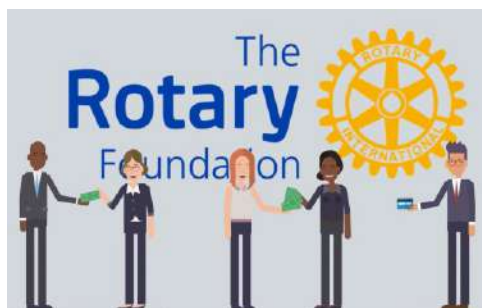

1. 1978

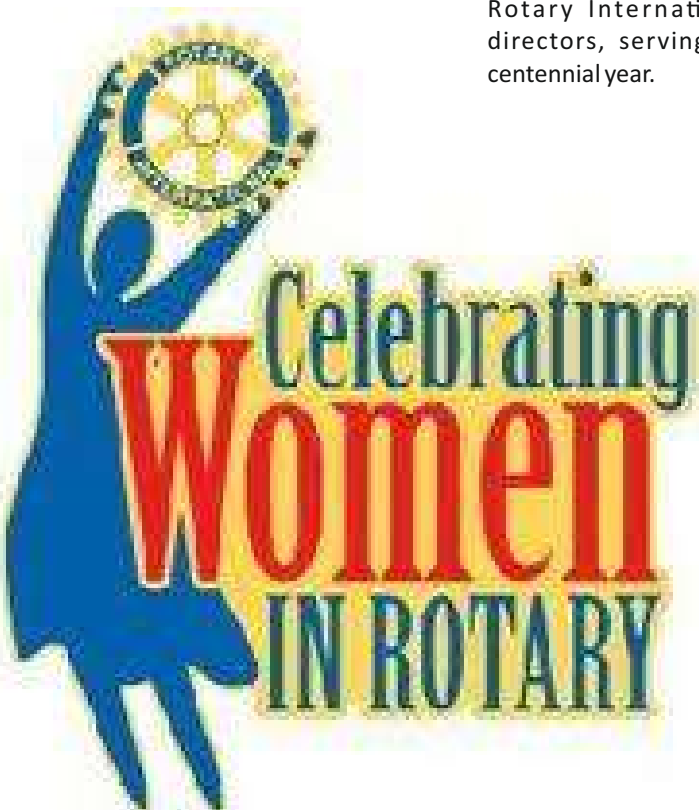
Sylvia Whitlock Joins Rotary

The Rotary Club of Duarte, California, broke Rotary rules by admitting women as members. Sylvia Whitlock, one of these women, went on to become the first female president of a Rotary club. Rotary International initially revoked the club's charter due to this violation.

2. 1983-1986

Court Battle for Inclusion

The Rotary Club of Duarte, led by Sylvia Whitlock and other club members, filed a lawsuit challenging Rotary's exclusion of women. The case went through several courts and garnered attention worldwide.



ROTARY BASICS

Women in Rotary

The inclusion of women in Rotary is a pivotal part of the organization's history, representing a shift towards greater diversity and equality. Here's a look at key milestones and developments related to women in Rotary:

3. 1987

U.S. Supreme Court Ruling

The United States Supreme Court ruled that Rotary Clubs could not exclude women from membership on the basis of gender. This landmark ruling opened the door for women to join Rotary in the United States and globally.

4. 1989

Women Officially Allowed in Rotary

At the Rotary International Council on Legislation, Rotary formally changed its constitution to admit women as members in all Rotary clubs worldwide. This decision allowed clubs globally to induct women, transforming the organization.

5. 1995

First Female District Governor

Lorna Riley became the first woman to serve as a Rotary District Governor, leading District 5240 in California, USA.

6. 2005

First Woman Rotary International Director

Catherine Noyer-Riveau from France became the first woman elected to Rotary International's board of directors, serving during Rotary's centennial year.

7. 2013

First Woman Trustee of The Rotary Foundation

Anne L. Matthews, from the USA, became the first female trustee of The Rotary Foundation, one of the most important leadership roles in the organization.

8. 2022-2023

First Woman President of Rotary International

Jennifer Jones from Canada became the first female President of Rotary International. Her presidency is a milestone moment, signifying the growing role of women in leadership within the organization.

9. 2024-2025

Stephanie Urchick, from Rotary Club of McMurray, Pennsylvania, USA is the Rotary International (RI) president for 2024-2025. Her theme for the year is "The Magic of Rotary".

Since the inclusion of women in Rotary, the organization has seen a significant increase in female membership and leadership roles. Women now play a key part in Rotary's global projects, leadership, and governance. In many regions, female membership continues to rise, and Rotary's commitment to diversity is evident in its clubs across the world.

Women have also been instrumental in some of Rotary's flagship initiatives, such as Polio Plus, efforts to improve education, water and sanitation projects, and peacebuilding. The organization continues to emphasize the importance of gender equality, seeking to provide more opportunities for women to contribute to and lead its efforts.

Women are now integral to Rotary's service projects, leadership, and global initiatives, contributing significantly to its mission of "Service Above Self."

Celebrating Culture & Power of Youth

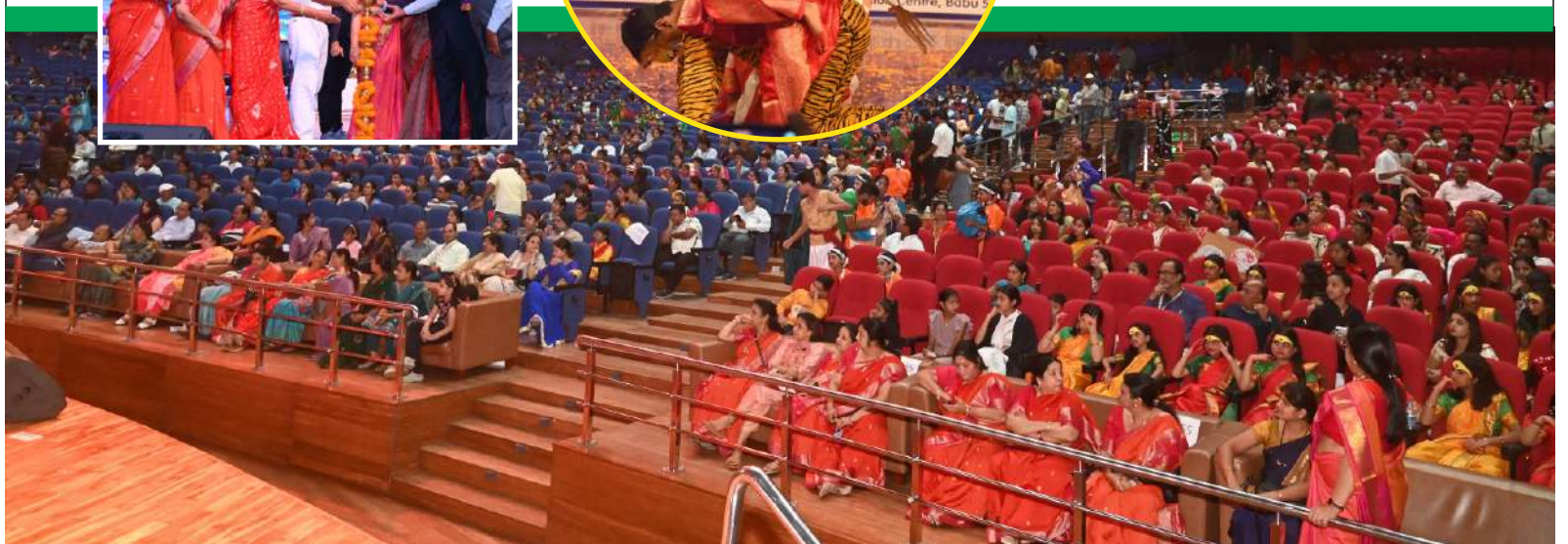
43rd Inter-School Folk Dance Competition - RC Pataliputra

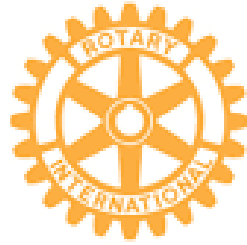

7. **Environment Projects:** Engage in tree planting or waste management activities that can be connected to grants supporting environmental sustainability.

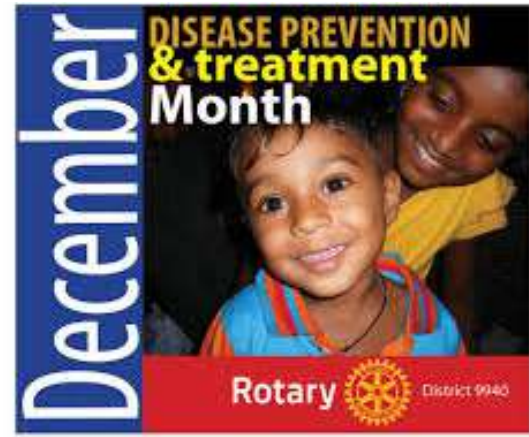
By focusing on these initiatives, clubs can honour and support the mission of the Rotary Foundation throughout November.
