Despite being just two hours from Mumbai, this village faces challenges such as unreliable electricity, leaving residents vulnerable to snake and scorpion bites at night. To address these hardships and improve living conditions, RCME provided essential supplies, including dustbins to promote hygiene, water barrels, toilet cleaners, nightgowns for women, and stationery kits with school bags for children. The success of this initiative was made possible through the generous contributions of dedicated sponsors: President Nidhika, who donated dustbins, toilet cleaners, and tadpatri; Reshma Patel, who provided water barrels; Sonia Kapoor, who gifted solar street lamps; Shweta Malpani, who contributed 40 sets of stationery and school bags; and Neha Bajaj, who donated 80 nightgowns. 
## RCME Movie Club Experiences Humare Ram: A Captivating Theatrical Journey
