



Health Initiatives: Reaching New Milestones

We kicked off the month with a heartwarming event at the Divyang Centre Camp in Dombivli, where a beneficiary was fitted with a prosthetic limb, restoring their mobility and independence. On September 20th, our Cervical Cancer Vaccination Camp at Balak Mandir School saw 125 young girls protected from a life-threatening disease—a powerful step toward promoting women's health.

The Swarna Prashan initiative at Shashank Vidhyalaya helped boost the immunity of 200 students, demonstrating our commitment to preventive healthcare. We closed the month with the RDC Camp in Mahad, where 26 beneficiaries were measured for prosthetic limbs in collaboration with Rotary Clubs of Mahad and Roha.

Empowering Through Education and Skills

Education remains a cornerstone of our service. The **Bakery Course** at Pragati College equipped students with valuable vocational skills, with exams and certificate distributions marking their achievement.

Through **RYPEN** (Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment), held on **September 21st** at Panchawati Farms, 82 students from Balak Mandir School were empowered with essential leadership and life skills. It's heartening to see young minds inspired to become tomorrow's changemakers.


PARTNER IN SERVICE (PIS) MEETING AT ACHIEVERS COLLEGE


