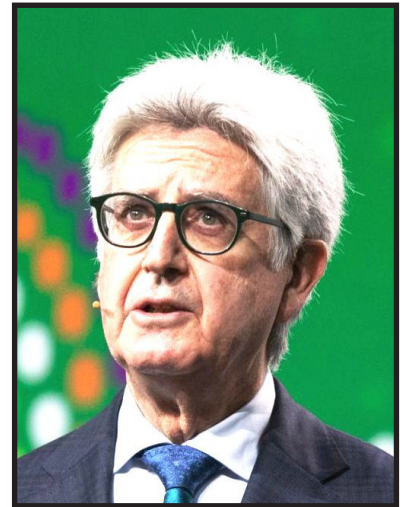

Meet RI President Francesco Arezzo

Francesco Arezzo, a member of the Rotary Club of Ragusa, Italy, was selected by the Board of Directors of Rotary International to become its President for 2025-26. Arezzo will take office on 1st July.

“The Board conducted a special session following the unexpected resignation of **RI President-elect Mário César Martins de Camargo on 8 th June**. Guided by the RI code and policies, the Board selected the new president-elect from a pool of candidates who were considered by the Nominating Committee for President of Rotary International in August 2023.”



The 2025-26 Presidential message, announced at the 2025 Rotary International Assembly in February, ***Unite for Good***, will continue. It calls on Rotary members to be a force for unity in a world increasingly divided by politics, geography, and ideology. Through service projects, Rotary brings together people of diverse backgrounds — across races, religions, and professions — in a shared mission to do well in the world. After all Rotary is not just about what we do but who we are when we do it together!

Dr Arezzo is an orthodontist by profession. He is active internationally as a member of the Italian, European, and American orthodontics associations. He is Vice President of the National Association of Italian Dentists for the province of Ragusa and was the founder and head for seven years of the delegation for Ragusa of the National Trust for Italy. He is a Knight of Honour and Devotion in Obedience within the Sovereign Order of Malta.

A Rotary member for more than 30 years, Rotarian Arezzo has served as Vice Chair of the Joint Strategic Planning Committee and as RI director, Learning Facilitator, and as the Rotary International President’s Representative at District Conferences too.

He is a Major Donor and Benefactor of The Rotary Foundation. He is married to Anna Maria Criscione, an entrepreneur in the tourism field. They have two children.

Through his all-encompassing vision he says, **“I don’t believe in leadership styles. Leadership is to dream with others”** in keeping with the message “Unite for Good”.

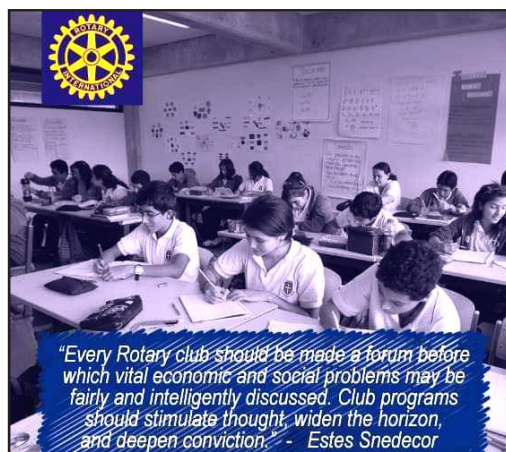
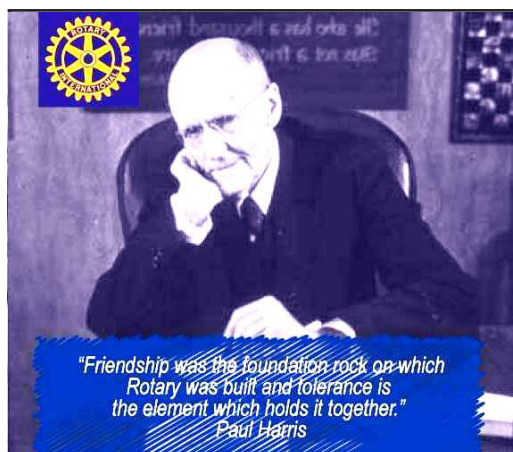

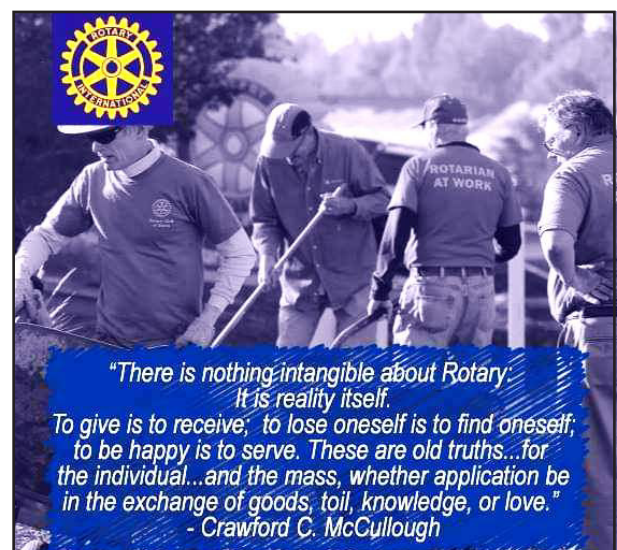
The other area of concern is the absence of registration of accounts on My Rotary. An expansive effort may be necessary to record progress on this front.

“The term “Rotary Year” starting on July 1st has been used to signify Rotary’s annual administrative period since at least 1913.

An article in The Rotarian that July noted, “The Rotary Year that is rapidly drawing to a close has been signalized by several highly successful joint meetings of Clubs that are so situated as to assemble together easily and conveniently.”

After the executive committee’s decision in 1913, the Rotary year ending has always been 30th June.

Let us take this opportunity to inspire students, strengthen Interact, and make a lasting impact. More exciting updates and program details will follow shortly!

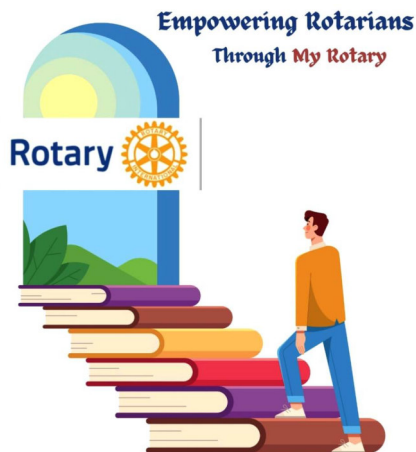

ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Council on Legislation 2025 :

Delegates from Rotary districts around the world met April 13-17 in Chicago for the 2025 Council on Legislation and approved, after extensive debate, an increase in Rotary dues and the creation of small-member clubs.

Delegates voted to increase the dues each Rotarian pays to Rotary International by \$3.50, meaning dues will rise from \$82 for 2025/2026 to \$85.50 for 2026/2027. Dues will increase by \$3.75 for each of the following two years.

The Council also approved a measure that will allow clubs to be created with only 15 members instead of 20.

Supporters of the measure believe it will remove barriers to forming new clubs and allow Rotary to grow and expand its reach by experimenting with innovative club models.

The Sylvia Whitlock Leadership Award

The award is presented annually to a Rotary member who has actively promoted the advancement of women in Rotary.

It is named after the first female Rotary club president who went on to change the status of women around the world through Rotary.

A group of Rotarians launched the award in 2017.

The Rotary Board decided in 2021 to make it an official Rotary International award to support the goal of increasing the number of women in Rotary, particularly in leadership positions.

There was no recipient for this award that year. Nominations are open from August 1 to 31 each year.

Rotarians and Rotaractors may nominate any member in good standing, regardless of gender or seniority in Rotary.

The award symbolizes Rotary's commitment to women's equality and leadership.

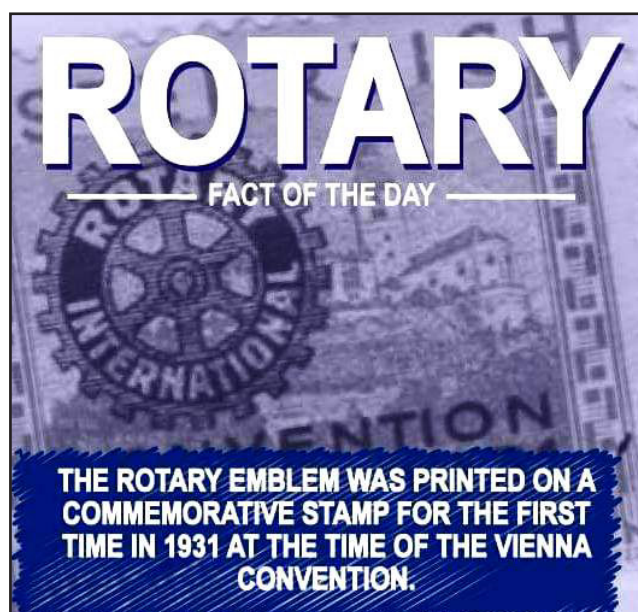

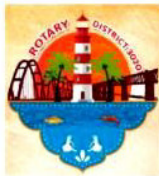
