MOSQUITO NET DISTRIBUTION PROJECT

Dengue has recently thrown a challenge to people of the state and everywhere its threat has taken an alarming proportion. Rotary District 3291 and its member clubs have risen to the occasion to help the city's weaker sections in fighting the menace of Dengue through a project of distribution of Mosquito nets, mainly in slum areas. Team Acropolis took part in the drive and distributed 100 nets in slum areas of CIT Road in North Kolkata and Selimpur in South Kolkata- 50 nets in each area. Out of 100 nets 50 were procured from the Rotary District at a discounted price.

This project of Team Acropolis is aimed at benefitting 100 families directly, thereby extending the benefits to 400 beneficiaries. The project cost is Rs.20,000/-.
