'PEP UP - A WELL BEING' MH GG PROJECT









The 'Well Being Project' was formally launched on 15th July 2025. The first phase of the project started on 23rd July and was completed on 20th August covering 2,565 students from 5 schools, one Junior college for boys and for girls each, and one engineering (degree) college. The issues to be covered were categorised as Physical, Mental, Emotional/Verbal and Sexual. The students were cooperative, responsive and some of them even volunteered and approached the counsellors personally. This showed the trust on confidentiality and warmth extended by the counsellors. Overall the feedback was overwhelmingly positive and satisfactory.







The second phase of our mental health program commenced on 25th August which has been initiated in 6 institutions and has covered 1468 students so far. The assessment is still ongoing and will be concluded by the end of October.




