{RYPEN Session on "Clean Air for Blue Skies"}

On Monday, 30th Sep 2024, the Rotary Club of Kalyan City successfully organized a RYPEN (Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment) session on the important theme of "Clean Air for Blue Skies" at St. Jude's High School, Kalyan East. The event aimed to educate students about the importance of clean air and the impact of air pollution on the environment and public health. The program was held with the cooperation of the school's Principal, Father Dominic Savio, Science Teacher Sarita and the dedicated teaching staff. Opening of the SessionThe session was opened by PP Rtn. Yakub Bhetasiwala, who took the opportunity to introduce Rotary International to the students. He spoke about Rotary's global mission of service and highlighted Rotary's successful contribution to eradicating Polio, an inspiring example of how collective efforts can lead to significant societal benefits. Yakub emphasized that Rotary's focus on improving community health and welfare aligns well with the theme of clean air.

Interactive Session by Guest Speaker Rupali ShaiwaleThe key part of the program was an engaging and interactive session led by environmental expert Rupali Shaiwale from Paryavaran Dakshata Mandal. Rupali interacted with the students to make them aware of the importance of clean air, explaining the adverse effects of air pollution on human health and the ecosystem. She highlighted simple, effective methods that everyone can practice to contribute to cleaner air, such as reducing vehicle emissions, using public transport, and limiting the use of fossil fuels. To further deepen the students' understanding, Rupali organized a demonstration in collaboration with the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB). A mobile calibration van was brought to the school, giving the students a rare, hands-on experience. MPCB Mobile Calibration Van ExperienceStudents were thrilled to witness and learn about the Mobile Calibration Van used by MPCB for air quality monitoring and calibration. This van is equipped with PM10 and PM2.5 analyzers certified by leading international bodies such as EPA, TUV, and MCERTS. These analyzers are part of a Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring System (CAAQMS) that measures particulate matter in

Impact of the ProjectThe "Clean Air for Blue Skies" session successfully raised awareness among the students about the critical issue of air pollution and equipped them with practical knowledge about air quality monitoring. The live demonstration of the MPCB mobile calibration van added a hands-on dimension to the event, making it an unforgettable experience for the students and teachers alike. This RYPEN session is a part of Rotary's broader mission to foster environmental responsibility among the younger generation and empower them to take action for a cleaner and healthier future. the air. The students learned that the van uses advanced online monitoring instruments to measure other air quality parameters like sulfur dioxide (SO2), nitrogen oxides (NOx), suspended particulate matter (SPM), and carbon monoxide (CO).In addition to air quality data, the van is also equipped to collect meteorological data, including temperature, humidity, wind speed, and wind direction, giving the students insight into how weather conditions affect air quality. The students, along with their teachers, had the opportunity to visit inside the van, observe the sophisticated instruments in action, and gain valuable knowledge about the methods used to monitor air quality. The experience sparked curiosity and interest among the students, making the learning process highly interactive and impactful.

Conclusion and Acknowledgments The session concluded with Rotary Club President, Hycenth Bhetasiwala, thanking the guest speaker Rupali Shaiwale for her invaluable contribution to the event. She also extended his gratitude to Principal Father Dominic Savio, teacher Sarita, the teaching staff, and all the students for their enthusiastic participation in this vital learning experience.
