The school has 410+ children from class PP1 to 5

We were greeted by happy faces of the children at the entrance. All of the members paid homage to Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose on his Birthday. A joint RWM was conducted and efforts of the committee and school staffs were appreciated.

Under the project we distributed

- Books and uniforms to the students.
- Shoes worth Rs.10,00,000/- to the children.
- Biscuits and Maggi under our Project Food Bank
- Children Play area on the terrace spanning 4500/- $sq\ ft$ with turf and complete boundaries was inaugurated
- We inaugurated e-Learning facility at the school where Television sets have been installed in all the classrooms with e-Learning content
- We handed over 2 Nos on Totos which will add to the fleet of existing 10 Totos which are being used ferry children to school
- We inaugurated the new website of the school www.rotaryvivekanandaschool.org In the afternoon we were joined by RID Aniruddha Roy Choudhary and District Governor Hira Lal Yadav. They appreciated and applauded the efforts made by both clubs towards the school.


