

Mahanagar RCC



BOYNALA RCCM is making strides in community development through targeted education and health programs. Under the guidance of dedicated Trainer Amaresh Manna, a series of computer classes were successfully held to equip local learners with essential digital skills. On February 1, 2026, from 2 to 4 PM, three learners participated; this was followed by a morning session on February 3, 2026, from 6:30 to 8:30 AM, benefiting nine individuals; and another afternoon class on February 7, 2026, from 2 to 4 PM, serving five more learners. Complementing these efforts, BOYNALA RCCM extended its outreach to healthcare with a specialized clinic led by Dr. JagatpatiNaskar (Homeo). On January 29, 2027, from 4 to 6 PM, the session attended to six patients, providing valuable homeopathic consultations. BOYNALA RCCM is empowering local women through hands-on skill-building with back-to-back tailoring classes led by expert Trainer Sangita Sardar. On February 5, 2026, from 3 to 5 PM, three dedicated learners honed their sewing techniques, followed by an equally productive session on February 6, 2026, during the same hours, again benefiting three participants. These initiatives not only impart valuable vocational skills but also foster self-reliance in the community—kudos to Sangita Sardar and the BOYNALA RCCM team for their steadfast commitment!



Menstrual Hygiene Management



On 3 February 2026, 100 girl students from Basana Devi MSK received hands-on training and reusable sanitary napkins through our Girls Empowerment Grant. Previously unfamiliar with reusable sanitary napkins, the students now possess the confidence to use them effectively. Most hail from the minority community. The day's project, with a total cost of INR 20,000, marked a meaningful step



toward empowerment and menstrual hygiene awareness.



Hygiene and Sanitation



Rotary Club Mahanagar has reached a major milestone in its transformative Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) initiative in North 24 Parganas, with the construction of 657 household toilets nearing completion. Training and awareness sessions for beneficiaries are now in full swing, conducted by dedicated trainers to ensure sustainable usage and hygiene practices. Food Bank



Rotary Mahanagar has been at the forefront of combating hunger through an inspiring series of food distribution drives, touching the lives of hundreds of children across Kolkata and nearby areas. On February 5, 2026, 200 students at Shalimar Hindi Primary School near Shalimar Station, along with 100 children from nearby slums, received vital nourishment. This momentum continued on February 6 with multiple impactful sessions: 60 students at Shitla Hindi Vidyalaya 1954 in Andul; 250 students at Shree Shanti Vidyalaya in Shibpur near Avani Mall; and dual distributions totaling 500 children—200 packets for 50 kids at ShubhiNalbhadh (Bishnupur) in Boynala Village, and another 250 at Rotary MahanagarNetralaya. The latter events saw distinguished Rotarians including PDG Nancy Barbee and her team from the USA, Rtn Shekhar Mehta with Rashi Mehta at Netralaya, Rtn Kavita Bhalotia, Rtn Mahesh Sonthalia, Rtn Sharad Agarwal, Rtn Pradeep Agrawal, President Sanjay Bhalotia, plus Rtn Ashok Agarwal, Rtn Usha Agarwal, Rtn Kamlesh Agarwala, RtnKallol Ghosh, and RtnSanghamitra Ghosh.




