#### Netralaya





On 18th January, Netralaya organized an eye camp for 8 patients from the homeopathy clinic. All underwent successful cataract surgeries, marking another step towards improved vision and well-being.

Between 29th December 2024 and 21st January 2025, a total of 66 free SICS surgeries and 9 NPCB cases were completed by the end of December. In January, the work continued with 11 Phaco surgeries, 14 paid SICS surgeries, 175 free SICS surgeries, and 47 NPCB cases

On 16th January 2025, the Rotary Club of Calcutta Mahanagar organized a Free Mega Medical Camp at Vill Bamihati, Habra. Sponsored by Rtn Girish Soni, the camp provided a range of essential healthcare services to the local community. A total of 185 individuals benefited from general health check-ups, while 33 cataract cases were identified for further intervention. Additionally, 55 patients underwent ECG tests, and 72 spectacles were distributed to those in need. The camp served as a vital initiative in promoting health and well-being, ensuring accessible medical support for the underserved population.

#### Bloodline











Between 19.12.2024 and 17.01.2025, the Rotary Club of Calcutta Mahanagar conducted several impactful initiatives under its Bloodline project. Blood Grouping and Donation Camps were held on 20.12.2024, 09.01.2025, and 13.01.2025, registering 171 SOS donors and supporting 5 patients. On 16.01.2025, a free eye and health checkup camp benefitted over 200 villagers, while on 17.01.2025, a camp provided blood donation, grouping, and healthcare to over 150 individuals, with 72 donors participating. In a critical

case on 17.01.2025, the club arranged "O-" blood for a 2-year-old's surgery, showcasing its commitment to saving lives. These initiatives highlight the club's dedication to community service and health awareness.



#### **Skill Development**













On Tuesday, December 31st, a certificate distribution ceremony was held at the Fultala, Baruipur Training Hall of Samaj Unnyan Kendra. The event recognized 200 beneficiaries who had completed skill development training under GG 1871537. The training programs included Tailoring (80 beneficiaries), Beautician courses (80 beneficiaries), and Nursing Support (40 beneficiaries). The ceremony was attended by Chairman PP Chitra Agarwal, Rtn Pradeep Agarwal, spouse Manju Agarwal, and other dignitaries. In addition to distributing certificates, chocolates from the organization's food bank were given to the attendees, adding a sweet touch to the celebration.

The skill development program (Grant GG 1871537) for Home-Based Care Givers and Security Guards, supported by the Rotary Club of Calcutta Mahanagar, was completed. A Valedictory Program and Certificate Distribution Ceremony was held on January 10, 2025, at Sandhya Nir Community Hall, Madhyamgram, to celebrate the trainees' achievements. The event, attended by Rotary members, marked a significant step in empowering individuals with vocational skills for better livelihoods.

A total of 88 beneficiaries completed training in caregiving and security services. The event was attended by the Chairman of Madhyamgram Municipality, officials, and Rtn. 
