

On the 10 th of November we had an insightful RWM at The Coffee House of the Alipore Jail Museum, with Ms. Smita Chakraburtty as our guest speaker. Smita was an esteemed Indian researcher and activist known for her impactful work in prison reform and criminal justice across India. Her dedication had brought significant attention to the conditions of inmates, particularly undertrial prisoners, in various Indian prisons. Her talk was a powerful revelation for all attending members and their spouses. She shared how her efforts had uncovered the struggles faced by undertrial prisoners, many of whom remained incarcerated for extended periods without trial. Smita's contributions had spurred judicial and government reforms, encouraging steps to improve prison

conditions and uphold the rights of undertrials. Notably, her recommendation to establish open jails like those in Rajasthan across all Indian states had been endorsed by the Supreme Court, with implementation already underway.
