

FREE MEDICAL CAMP FOR TRIBAL PEOPLE IN PALGHAR DISTRICT



TO THREE SCHOOLS IN DAHANU, DISTRICT **WADA**

On 21st Oct we distributed 1200 Sanitary Pads to girls of three schools in Dahanu, jointly supported by Rotary Club of Dahanu and Rotary Club of Mumbai Bravehearts. The napkins have a life of two years. The children were made aware, taught the importance of personal hygiene and how to use the pads. The children come from the poorest of poor homes. We need to provide the children with footwear as they have to walk for miles on stones and mud. The school does not have wash stations. We propose to provide them with two wash stations with 10 to 12 taps. The electricity keeps failing and school does not have money to meet large electricity bills. We propose to set up solar panels. One of the children had a very serious eye problem - near blind which Dr Cyres Mehta has agree to attend. Tribal women and children who live in kaccha dwellings, without electricity, in hamlets inside the Park will be trained on Digital Skills which will help them to market the lovely bags, pouches, purses, handicrafts, fridge bags and other products they make. The purpose is to create self-employment and sustainable livelihood and empowering the tribal communities living in the forests. Thank you all the donors. It was a half-day picnic in the 108 sq kms National Park. We also saw the different kinds of plants (Ayurvedic) that grow there. This was followed by sumptuous lunch. The Eye Check involved Check-up for Far vision by Vision Screen Chart (Digital), Check-up for Near Vision with Near Chart and Trial box and Trial frame, Torch Eye examination - Autorefractometer checking for cataract, distribution of spectacles at discounted rates of 100/- per reading glass to 127 beneficiaries. Total beneficiaries more than 900. OCTOBER

General Health OPD – No of OPDs – 21 and Patients covered 1391 and patients referred 9. Special Health Education 28 sessions were held for 215 community people. The team conducted 78 one on one sessions for patients. On 13th Oct a Mega health check-up camp was held at Kharekuran Village, Palghar. 187 patients benefited. Ophthalmic screening camp wherein a total of 220 beneficiaries participated in ophthalmic camp. 126 spectacles were distributed and 27 people were referred for further treatment. Dental check-up camp beneficiaries - 167. The MMU organized Special Health check-up camp for community people at Mhada, Vashinaka which included Blood Glucose Testing. Total 66 community people benefited. Total beneficiaries 2246

NOVEMBER

General Health OPD - No of OPDs - 19. Patients covered 960 and patients referred 7. The MMU organized Anemia screening camp for 23 community women. Women were treated with 90 days' supply of IFA supplements, and a one-time de-worming tablet to improve their health status. Special Health Education 24 sessions were organized for 249 community people. The team has also conducted 135 one on one sessions for the patients. Team conducted a Health check-up camp at Manivali Village, Wada. A Total number of 100 patients (70 villagers and 30 ZP School students) benefited from this camp. Ophthalmic Camp - Special camp was organized at Limboni Baug, Chembur. A total of 47 (10 male & 37 Female) beneficiaries participated in ophthalmic camp.









20th December

CHRISTMAS LUNCH FOR ORPHANS AT FATHER AGNELS ORPHANAGE

Our Club had organised Christmas Lunch for 41 children and 10 staff members of Fr Agnel's Orphanage. 
