






शीर्षक -"बारिश और वो तुम्हारी छतरी "



Rotary's Quest For Sustainable World



The world is increasingly becoming worried about climate change. The heat wave this year has seen mercury touching unbearable levels of 50 deg cent at some places. This is a stark reminder that though humans are considered the most intelligent, their uncontrolled greed and consumption is pushing them towards destruction.

Scientists have been foretelling such scenarios for the last two centuries. James Fourier was the first scientist in 1824 to hint of the existence of greenhouse cover responsible for raising the temperature of earth. Eunice Foote, in 1856, explained the composition of greenhouse cover and John Tydall in 1860 found any change in composition of greenhouses could change its impact on earth's climate. Svante Arrhenius, a Swedish scientist, in 1896 first time recognized the negative impact of increase in carbon dioxide content on the climate. In 1938 Guy Callendar conclusively proved that unabated rapid proliferation of human activity and consumption was increasing carbon di oxide percentage in atmosphere and was accelerating climate change. Slowly people worldwide started sharing their concern and called for a global, universal and a collective approach. In the meantime, the signs of global warming and climate change were becoming noticeable and the world started taking these stark warnings seriously. This hue and cry and increased concern of many governments lead to formation of an Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change under the aegis of UN in 1990. This panel became a repository of all knowledge related to climate change and started publishing their reports annually. The first IPCC report in 1990 resulted in milestone international treaty UNFCCC. Similarly subsequent reports resulted in Kyoto protocol, restricting increase in temperature to 2 deg cent. The annual meetings of COP or the Conference of Parties which is the highest governing body of UNFCCC has been playing the difficult role of bringing consensus amongst all countries. Presently 192 countries have accepted Kyoto Protocol. Another major hurdle was crossed in 2016 when on 1st January seventeen number Sustainable **Develop Goals were adopted.**







These seventeen goals cover all the aspects of human activity and its impact on environment. The summary of seventeen goals is as

- End poverty
- End hunger
- Ensure healthy lives and promote wellbeing for all.
- Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education
- Gender equality
- Water and sanitation for all.
- Affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all.
- Decent work for all.
- Build resilient infrastructure,
- Reduce inequality
- Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable.
- Sustainable consumption and production
- Combat climate change
- Conserve oceans, seas and marine resources
- Sustainably manage forests
- Promote peaceful and inclusive societies
- Strengthen global partnership

The important point to note is that all the projects of Rotary are aligned with the seventeen sustainable development goals of UN.



Rotary District 3142 signs MoU with Thane Municipal Corporation to enhance living conditions of less privileged

Thane: In a bid to uplift the less privileged communities, Rotary District 3142 has partnered with the Thane Municipal Corporation (TMC) through a Mem-

orandum of Understanding (MoU). The signing ceremony, graced by Chief Secretary of Maharashtra Mrs. Sujata Saunik, IAS, marked the installation District Governor Rtn Dinesh Mehta. Past

International President Rtn K R Ravindran from Sri Lanka also attended as the chief guest.

The MoU aims to implement several impactful initiatives, including a cervical cancer vaccination drive for girls aged 9 to 14, the Rotary Knowledge Enhancement and Training Centre, Project Nikshay for TB patients' nutrition support, the IWILL GITA App for mental health therapy, and the period. Additionally, a Skill Development Centre, supported by RC Thane Lakecity, RC Thane Greencity, and RC Thane North, is set to be established, featuring an auditorium,



E-learning Ideal Study App for Maharashtra State Board students.

Under Project Nikshay, Rotary District 3142 aims to make the district TB-free by providing free nutrition to 1,500 patients during their treatment conference room, and training centres.

The partnership also includes plans for constructing 50 check dams, in collaboration with Lions District 3231 - A2, to bolster water conservation efforts in the region.
