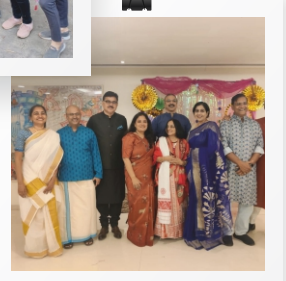
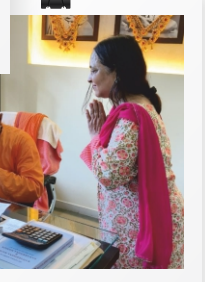
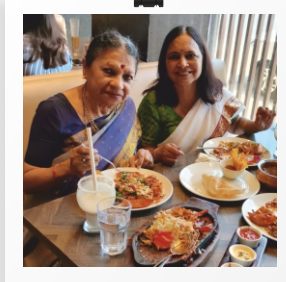
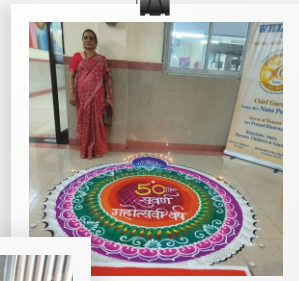
We would like to organize multiple one day picnics within Mumbai as well as some longer trips both to domestic as well as international destinations.

RI PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE


Dear fellow Rotary leaders:

Nilesh is a keen sports person with interest in Cricket, Cycling and Badminton.

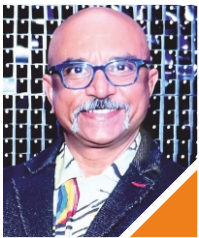


Rtn. Nishant Bafna
