

History of our District 3012

Our erstwhile District 3010 comprising of the National Capital Territory of Delhi came into being on July 1, 1984 as R.I. District 301. It was renumbered 3010 in Rotary Year 1991-92.

The first club in this region, Rotary Club of Delhi, was started in 1938 and received its charter on January 18, 1938. By 1970, 7 more new clubs had been formed in this region. The 70s saw significant growth, and by July 1, 1984, there were 39 clubs in the District followed by 135 clubs as on 30th June 2015.

District 3010 was re-organised and redistricted into two new districts 3011 and 3012 with effect from the Rotary Year 2015-2016.

Our district 3012 comprises of Delhi, Sonapat revenue district in Haryana, Ghaziabad & Gautam Budh Nagar revenue districts in U.P. with 120 clubs and around 3603 Rotarians with 25% female members (as of 2nd July 2021). Our new District is very active in fulfilling the objectives of Rotary and is committed to the ideal of Community service. Apart from the various activities undertaken by individual clubs, our District is credited with signature projects which have made a significant impact in the community.
