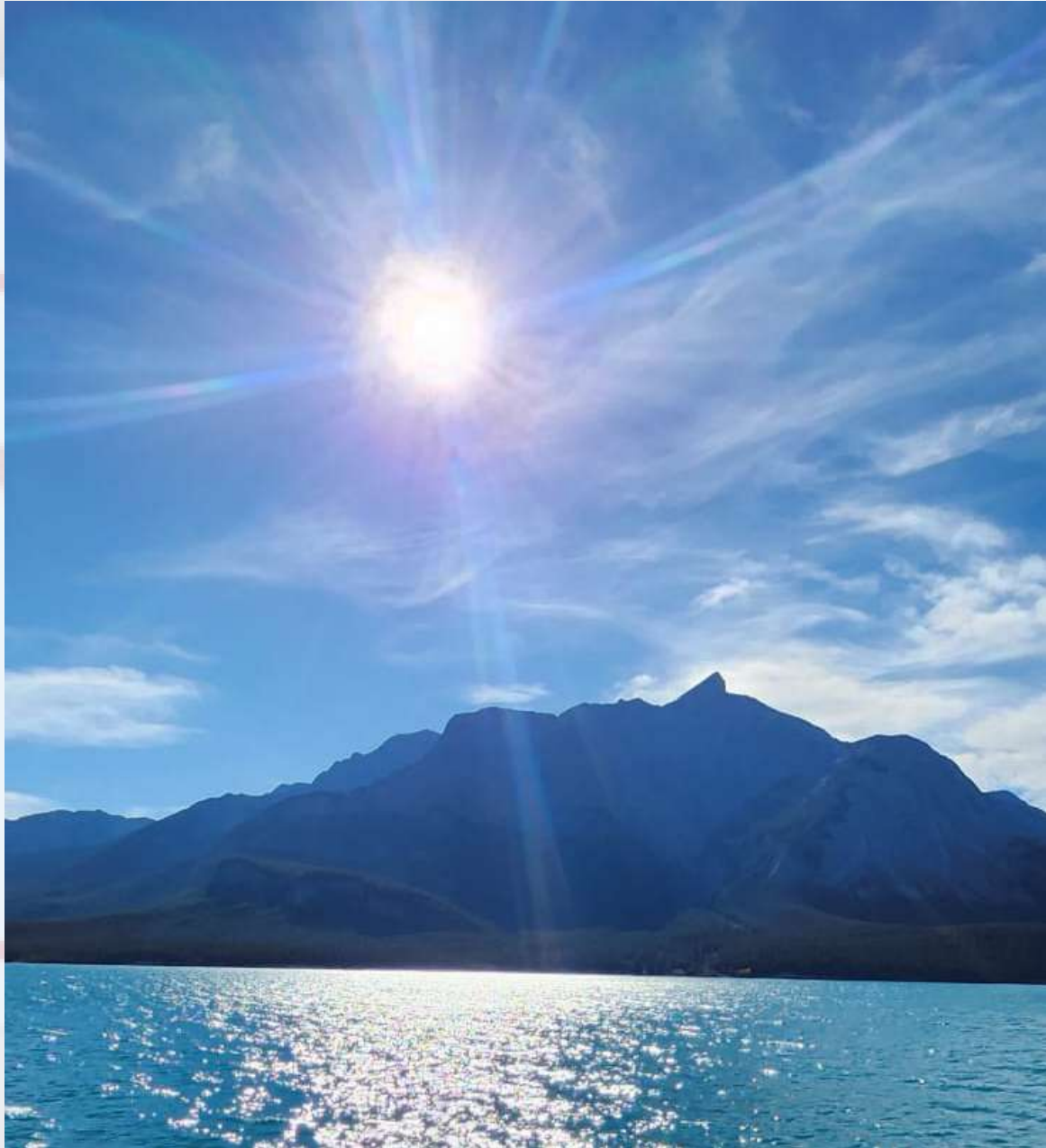

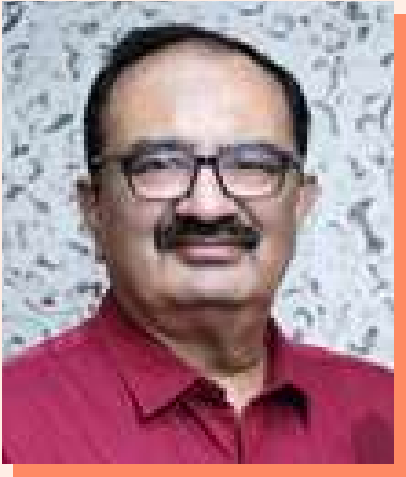

Friends , having toured a lot of locales around the world , had this strange itch to visit one of the domestic tourist spots and by chance narrowed on to Tadoba. And we never regretted our decision.

Well, this is one reserve located near Nagpur, Chandrapur district to be precise, about 2 hours drive from Nagpur station. We took the train route, wanting to taste the railway travel since long, and frankly we had a fabulous experience, stretching our legs to their maximum as the stations passed and being well fed all along.

The road trip ended as we entered the dense jungles of Tadoba, we soon checked into the Bagh Kothi Resort and immediately got ready for the first jungle Safari on an open Jeep with a four-wheel drive- so essential to drive through the rugged mountain slopes and river basins. Mind you these roads are not for the faint hearted and to add to the adventure the drivers drive them like mad. The next day was well spent with back-to-back safaris taking us across the length and breadth of the jungle. The jungle is one of a kind, dense vegetation, good flora and fauna. Unlike in many forest reserves where you hardly get to see any wild animals and you come back dejected, this is one place where you have plenty to see.

Well, we were lucky to sight 8 tigers, not a mean number, in different habitats and different state of alertness and activities. It is indeed a humbling experience visualizing these magnificent creatures from close quarters – some as close as 2-3 meters from where you are seated? They would hover around your vehicle, almost wanting to lick you. I was surprised why they never made a meal of us- maybe they hated Rotarians, what with our bloated egos and very little meat. So be it, at least we were saved to attend another of our Friday Rotary meetings and gave me a chance to write my experience!

Jokes apart, if there is one place on earth where you can sight Tigers and say it in plural and that too from such close quarters then it has to be Tadoba. Besides , we were lucky to see a lone leopard although momentarily. Then there are other animals who actually come in the out to witness the urban animal in Man and in the bargain, we could see a lot of deers , wild bisons, monkeys, mongoose, birds with variety of feathers.

All in all, a good experience, a relaxing outing with reasonably good resorts that serve you with love.

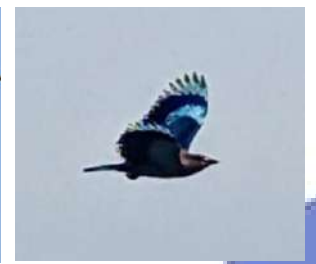
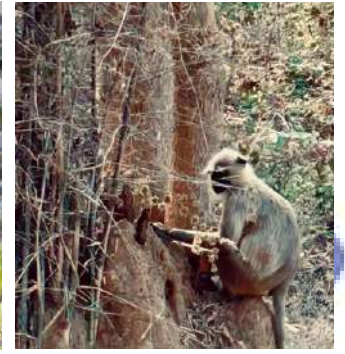
I would very much recommend this outing and more so because it is so near and accessible.

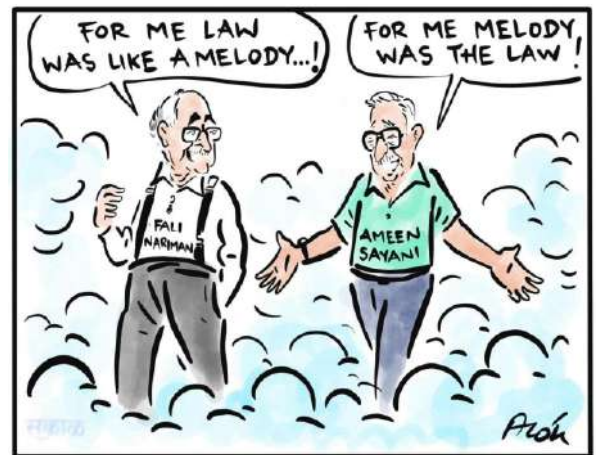
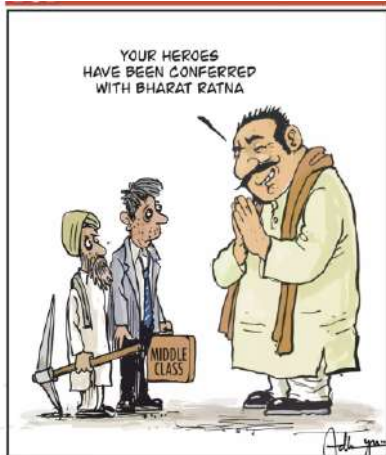
