Speaker Meeting March 28, 2025

Rotary Club Amritsar Midtown Hosts Informative Session on Canal-Based Water System

Rotary Club Amritsar Midtown held its regular meeting on March 28, 2025, at 7:00 PM at Bhavan's SL Public School, Amritsar. The highlight of the meeting was an insightful talk by the guest speaker, Er. Daljit Singh Kohli, on the topic **"Canal-Based Water System for Amritsar."**

Er. Kohli provided a comprehensive report on the ambitious project, detailing its capacity of **44 crore liters per day** and its sprawling **40acre water treatment plant** at Vallah Village. Designed with a **30year lifespan**, the project aims to revolutionize the water supply system in Amritsar. The development includes the construction of **51 new water tanks**, while **33 existing tanks** will be integrated into the network. A total of **112 kilometers of pipeline** will be laid to ensure seamless water distribution.

Once operational, the system will supply Amritsar's citizens with **mineral-rich water sourced from the River Ravi via the UBDC**

(Upper Bari Doab Canal). The anticipated launch date for this transformative project is **January 2027**.
