Born and brought up in the dream city of Mumbai, this vibrant personality's journey towards excellence began early. He was a high school topper and truly meritorious student, reflecting his commitment to education and self-improvement.

His impressive resume includes being among the first Microsoft certified trainers in India, showcasing his early recognition of the power of technology and the importance of staying at the forefront of the IT field.

With a background as a Mechanical Engineer turned IT Entrepreneur and Director of Vibrant Technologies, he's a dynamic individual with a passion for networking and software consultancy. His company having presence in India, USA and UK won many awards from Microsoft and RedHat for their outstanding performance as Authorized Training Partner.

His journey in Rotary began at RC Borivli in 2003-04, where he quickly made a mark as the best new Rotarian in his first year. His charismatic leadership skills were evident during his presidency in 2008-09, earning him a slew of awards, including the Excellent President award and recognition for outstanding international service projects.

He belives in leading by example, he is a major donor, PHS member, and a Gold Pin reciepient from RI for introducing over 10 members to Rotary. His philanthropic spirit extends to charitable endeavors, as he generously contributed to the Rotary Club of Borivli Charitable Trust in honor of his mother.

His hobbies are traveling, playing cricket and singing. He is the first IFCR (International Fellowship of Cricket loving Rotarians) member who rose to become DG.

But what truly defines him is his unwavering positivity and belief in the power of Now. CATARACT FREE BHANDUP CAMP

As a part of our ambitious project "Cataract Free Bhandup", cataract screening and eye check up camps are organised on the first Saturday of every month. It is going on from August 2022 regularly. Presently it is being organised at Datta Mandir, Near Hotel Gopalashram, Near Mulund Checknaka, Thane. So far we have screened nearly 1400 persons and carried out more than 600 cataract surgeries. This is in association with Bhaktivedanta Hospital and Research Institute, Mira Road and Billawar Association, Bhandup.



We meet every Thursday at Hotel Guru Prasad, Link Road, Mulund at 7.00 PM.

In the cataract screening and surgery camp held on 1st June 2024, 58 beneficiaries were screened and out of them 31 were detected for cataract.

They were sent to Bhaktivedanta Hospital at Mira Road on 2nd June 2024 and surgery was successfully carried out.

KNOW YOUR ASSISTANT GOVERNOR

Rotarian Ameeta Vohra joined Rotary Club of Bombay Powai in December 2005 under the classification as computer teacher. She was the club President in 2017-18. Since August 2022, A total of 1493 people have been screened for cataract and 658 persons underwent successful surgery. On 1st June 2024 we organized a program to celebrate the success of the project.

- * We donated Rs. 3 lakhs to the **National Integration Project** for training of nurses from Kashmir valley.
- * Quite a few medical camps like Prostate Awareness camp, Breast Cancer Awareness camp etc were organized.
- * We organized a medical check up camp for the inmates of **Haven Old Age Home in Bhandup** in association with RC of Mumbai Cuffe Parade.
- * **Skill Development Program** continued. 9 needy women were provided training in tailoring free of cost during the vear.
- * "Pink Auto Project" has been successfully implemented. 5 needy women have been provided with autorikshaws. The formal inauguration program was held on 15th June 2024.
- * During the year our club was very active in social media platforms like LinkedIn, Face Book and Instagram.
- * Organized "Rotary Fun Fiesta" program from 15th to 17th December 2023, at Pawar Public School Grounds at Bhandup. In addition to fundraising, the project created excellent publicity to our club. On the occasion inaugurated a 33 feet tall Christmas Tree, which broke India, Asia and world records.
- * Organized "Rotary Face of the Year" fashion show program on 14th February 2024.
- * We managed to increase the corpus of our Charitable Trust substantially during the year.
- * We participated in a Beach Cleaning project on 28th October 2023.
- * Our club received "Rotary Club Digital Excellence Award".
