CATARACT FREE BHANDUP CAMP

As a part of our ambitious project "Cataract Free Bhandup", cataract screening and eye check up camps are organised on the first Saturday of every month. It is organised at Satyavijay Society, Opp. Sarvoday Society, Jangal Mangal Road, Bhandup West. From February onwards the venue has been shifted to Datta Mandir, S. G. Barve Marg, Near Hotel Gopalashram, Near Mulund Checknaka, Wagle Estate Starting Road, Thane-400604. This is in association with Billavar Association, Bhandup and Bhaktivedanta Hospital and Research Institute, Mira Road.



In the camp held on 4th March 2023, **67** beneficiaries were screened, out of whom **31** were selected for operation. They were sent to Bhaktivedanta Hospital at Mira Road on 7th March 2023 and were successfully operated.



In the camp held on 1st April 2023, a total of **57** beneficiaries were screened out of which **20** were detected for cataract. They were sent to the Hospital at Mira Road on 2nd of April and were successfully operated.

Although the designated date for International Women's Day is the 8th of March, we do change the date mainly to make it convenient for the awardees to attend. This year we opted to felicitate six women achievers in the field of academics. All the six selected were outstanding teachers who were already recipients of National Awards, State Awards, or some other important awards. The six notable academicians picked up for the awards were **Dr. Radhike Khanna, Ms. Jean Gomes, Dr. Dolly Henery, Ms. Sangeeta Sohni, Dr. Sharmila Ghuge and Dr. Kusum Bisit.**



The teachers were presented with symbolically created trophies, a certificate, and a gift. All the teachers spoke in their response. Everyone had a different story to narrate, their struggle, sacrifices, achievements but what was common to each one of them was their love and passion to teach. One of the teachers, thanking our club said aptly, "No matter how many awards, every award is a recognition and an achievement by itself and there can never be a paucity of space in our hearts and homes.... they can pour in bountifully".

DISTRICT TRAINING ASSEMBLY

The important training program of the district "District Training Assembly" was held on Sunday 16th April 2023 at Hotel **ITC Grand Maratha**. The host club was **Rotary Club of Bombay Airport**.

The program commenced with an invocation song and a dance recital. **District trainer Dilip Mulay** called the meeting to order. After the National anthem, President of host club **Suvendra Mishra** formally welcomed the guests and delegates. This was followed by greetings and Curtain Raiser from **Convener Ashmi Parekh**. District Trainer Dilip Mulay then spoke very nicely on "**Purpose of the day**".

Being a natural orator RIDE Raju Subramanian mesmerized the audience with his fascinating delivery. The take aways are: 1. Personal touch is very important. 2. In Rotary we all are equals – no person is superior, including RI President or RI Director. 3. Working together works. 4. Be humble and simple. He appreciated and welcomed the National Integration Project proposed by DGE Arun Bhargava.

DGN Chetan Desai then briefly spoke about his plans for the year 2024-25. After announcements by DS Sandip Kedia and convener Ashmi Parekh, PE Dr. Akshay Mehta proposed the vote of thanks.

This 1st Plenary session was followed by two breakout sessions, one before the lunch and another after the lunch in six different rooms. PP Jaya Sooda on "Art of Public Speaking: Be A Voice; Not An Echo"

In the club meeting held on Thursday 23rd April 2023, PP Jaya Sooda, a member of Rotary Club of Bombay Mulund Valley and the current Assistant Governor, spoke on the interesting subject "The Art of Public Speaking: Be A Voice; Not An Echo". Jaya Sooda is an excellent speaker.

PP Jaya Sooda said that Public Speaking ability is an integral part of personality and Leadership Development. "Public Speaking is transformation of truth into a language that is perfectly intelligible to the people whom we are speaking to".

Art of public speaking involves the development of following skills:

1. Learn to stop speaking before the audience stops listening.

2. Learn to speak what the audience wants to hear.

3. Select an audience before preparing a speech.

4. Accept the fact that every speaker was a bad speaker when he began.

5. Accurate statistics and involvement in the subject are vital to good speaking.

6. Develop certain traits into your personality like ignorance of child, grace of youth, knowledge of elderly and self-control of a saint.

7. Grab every opportunity to speak in public whether you are good or not.

8. Intimate eye contact develops emotional bonding with the audience.

9. Emotions, statistics and humor are required to be blended in good speech.

Fear of Public Speaking:

1. Fear is a process of absorbing in illusionary energy.

2. Fear of failure always discourages one from attempting to speak.

3. The phenomenon of fear is termed Social Anxiety Disorder.

4. Fear is unfounded and is a result of anxiety developed because of psychological response.

5. Fear of ridicule, forgetfulness, shortage of words are frequently observed.

6. Fear can be reduced by attempting to speak often. Yoga helps a lot.

In conclusion PP Jaya Sooda said people forget what you said and how you said but remember how you made them feel. Audience decides your success in speaking. Don't irritate them or waste their time. Your honesty with your words is well perceived by your audience. Be what you are, speak what you like, words are yours, but thoughts are not.

President Uday Shetty then spoke about the projects and programs carried out during the month.
