KNOW ROTARY

Foundation Funding

- · Supports projects worldwide to promote peace and eradicate polio.
 - Funded primarily through Annual Fund-SHARE contributions.

Annual Fund-SHARE

- Encourages Rotarians to contribute annually and participate in Foundation grants or programs.
- Contributions are divided: 47.5% to World Fund, 47.5% to District Designated Fund, 5% for operating expenses.
- World Fund supports worldwide grant opportunities, and District Designated Fund is used by districts for specific projects.

Funding Cycle

- Contributions become available for use three years later.
- For example, contributions from 2021-22 are available for spending in 2024-25.
 - Districts decide how to use District Designated Fund.

Disaster Response Fund

- · Accepts cash donations and DDF contributions.
 - Serves as a general disaster-related reserve.
- Contributions count toward various recognition levels and club opportunities.

Endowment

- Ensures sustainable project funding.
- Principal gifts are never spent; spendable earnings fund grants and programs.
- Accepts various types of contributions, including cash, investments, life income gifts, testamentary gifts, and beneficiary designations.

Ways to Give

- Contributions can be made by credit card, check, wire transfer, or through Rotary clubs.


