Role of Interact Club in Rotary

Interact is a Rotary-sponsored service club that gives young people an opportunity to participate in fun and meaningful service projects while developing leadership skills and meeting new friends. The basic principle of the Rotary Interact is to help others. Our motto is "service above self".

Interact is a club for youth ages 12-18 who want to connect with others in their community or school. Interact club members have fun while carrying out service projects and learning about the world. Interact clubs organize at least two service projects a year: one that benefits their community and one that encourages international understanding. While Interact clubs receive guidance from individual Rotary clubs, they govern and support themselves.

The purpose of Interact is to provide opportunities for young people to work together in a world fellowship dedicated to service and international understanding.

The word "Interact" stands for international action. The international objectives are to develop leadership skills and personal integrity, to demonstrate helpfulness and respect for others, to understand the value of individual responsibility and hard work and to advance international understand and goodwill.

Service Above Self'. This is the motto for the Interact Club.

Interact support people to actively participate in their communities and lead fulfilling lives. To be able to 'do more', and need less support - with a common theme of "helping others to help themselves".

The goals of Interact are:

- 1. To recognize and develop constructive leadership and personal integrity.
- 2. To encourage and practice thoughtfulness of and helpfulness to others.











- 3. To create an awareness of the importance of home and family.
- 4. To build respect for the rights of others, based on recognition of the worth of each individual.
- 5. To emphasize acceptance of individual responsibility as the basis of personal success, community improvement, and group achievement.
- 6. To develop life skills including self development, time management, and personal finances.
- 7. To recognize the dignity and value of all useful occupations as opportunities to serve society.
- 8. To provide opportunities for gaining increased knowledge and understanding of community, national, and world affairs.
- 9. To open avenues of personal and group action leading to the advancement of international understanding and goodwill toward all peoples

The Interact Club of Melbourne High School, sponsored by the Rotary Club of Melbourne, Florida, USA, became the first Interact club on 5 November 1962.

Two months later, the first Interact club outside the United States was established in Tanjore, India.

Today, there are approximately 14,900 clubs in 145 countries.

There is NO fee for certifying an Interact club.

RCBIA sponsored INTERACT CLUB of St. Anthony's Higher Secondary School is performing well since last 7 years.

- 1. Collection of Nirmalya in Ganesh festival & Navratri is an on going project. Interact members collect Nirmalya from their home and neighbours, bring it to school. Further sent to Shashwat Nursery for processing.
- 2. From this year we will provide technical support to process the Nirmalya within school premises and convert it to fertilizer and will be feeded to plants within school premises.
- 3. Members collected dry grocery and donated to Satkarm Orphanage.
- 4. National Swachhata Day also observed by Interact members.
