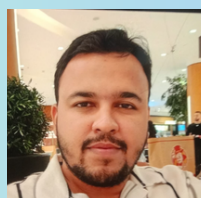

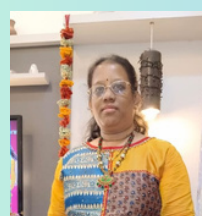

4. ज्ञान आणि विचार:

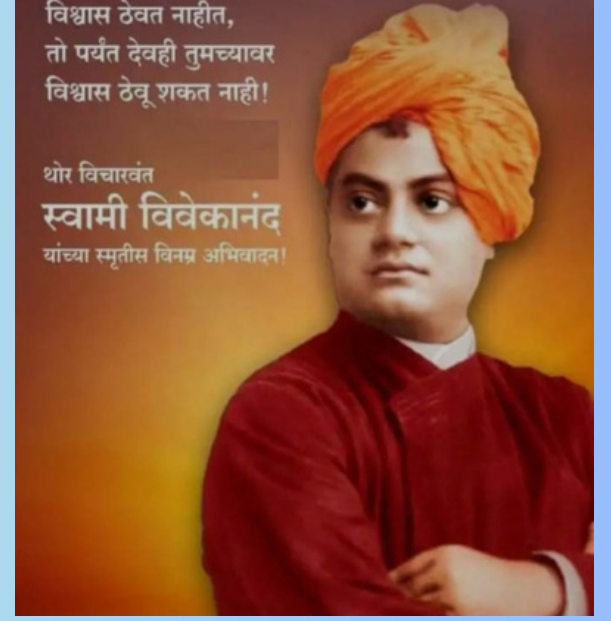

She was very much impressed about the initiative of cataract operation, plastic collection drive and Ganapati idol making activities.

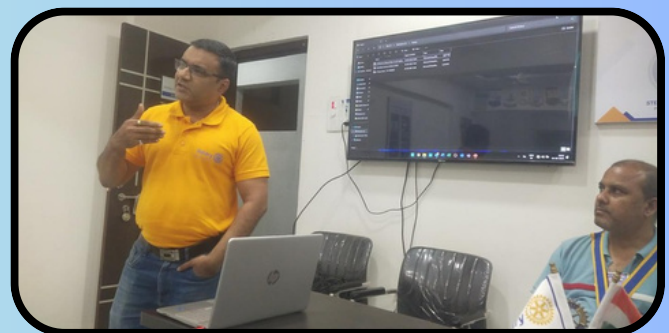
She also said that you can get a Global Grant for this initiative.
