Healthy Ahmednagar Initiative (Mosquito Nets Distribution, Part I)

The Healthy Ahmednagar Initiative (Mosquito Nets Distribution, Part I) was a focused public health campaign conducted in collaboration with the Municipal Corporation. Under this initiative, 1000 mosquito nets and drain caps were distributed to 1000 families throughout the community. This strategic distribution is designed to help prevent the breeding of mosquitoes

and reduce the spread of mosquito-borne diseases.

The nets and drain caps serve a dual purpose: they act as a physical barrier to protect families from mosquito bites and help control mosquito populations by preventing stagnant water from becoming breeding grounds. By implementing these preventive measures, the initiative aims to significantly lower the risk of diseases such as dengue and malaria, thereby contributing to the

overall health and well-being of the community.

This event highlights the strong commitment of Rotary Club of Ahmednagar Midtown to community health and preventive care. Through active collaboration with the Municipal Corporation, the project not only provided essential health resources but also raised public awareness about the importance of environmental management and personal protection in disease prevention.
