In response to these findings, the Rotary Club of Ahmednagar - Midtown plans to organize lectures and camps focused on Dietary Awareness. These initiatives will aim to educate the community on how to improve and maintain their health, thereby increasing the pool of eligible blood donors.

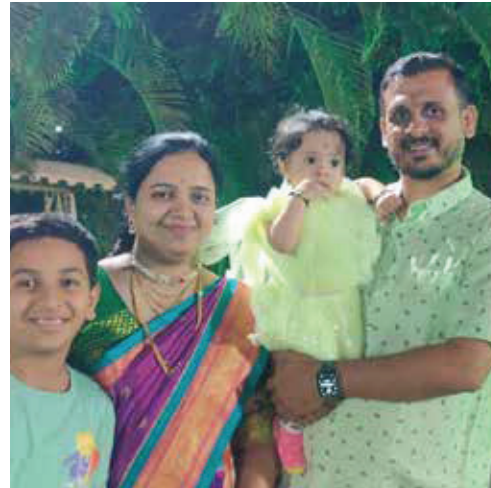

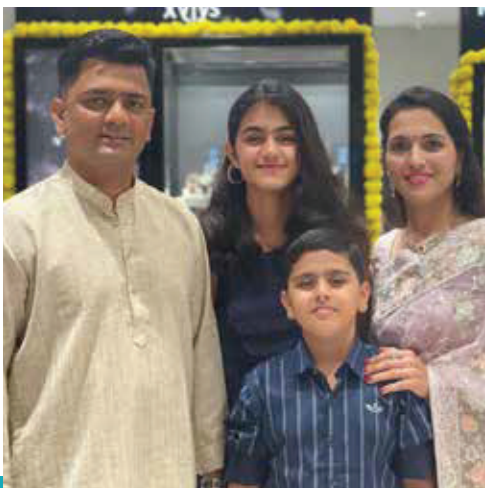
