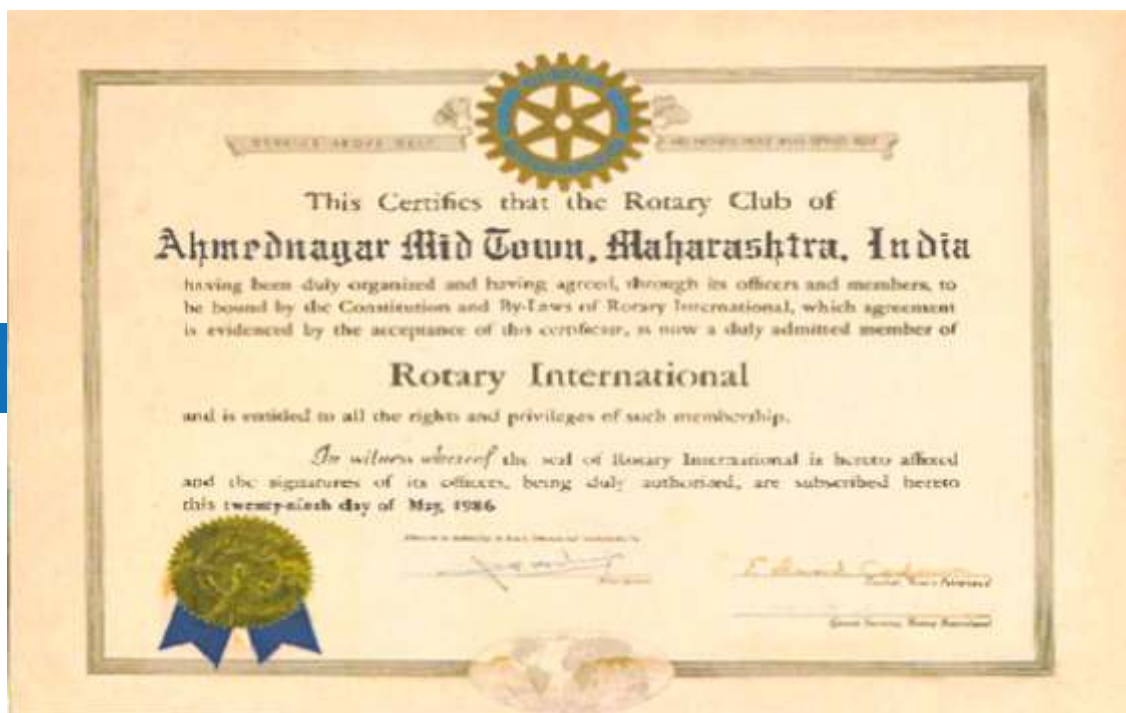

Basics



Rotary International is a global humanitarian organization that brings together business and professional leaders to provide community service, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace. Founded in 1905 by Paul P. Harris in Chicago, Illinois, Rotary has grown into a worldwide network of over 1.4 million members in more than 46,000 clubs across over 200 countries and regions.

Key Aspects of Rotary International:

1. **Mission and Vision:**

Mission: Rotary's mission is to provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through its fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.

Vision: Rotary's vision is to create lasting change—across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves.

2. **Avenues of Service: Rotary's work is organized around five primary avenues of service:**

Club Service: Strengthening fellowship and ensuring the smooth functioning of the club.

Vocational Service: Encouraging Rotarians to apply their professional skills in service to others and uphold high ethical standards.

Community Service: Improving the quality of life in local communities through various service projects.

International Service: Promoting peace, understanding, and global service through international projects and collaborations.

Youth Service: Empowering youth and young professionals through programs like Rotaract, Interact, and Youth Exchange.



3. The Rotary Foundation: The Rotary Foundation is the charitable arm of Rotary International. It supports a wide range of humanitarian and educational projects globally. The Foundation's areas of focus include:

Promoting peace

Fighting disease (notably the eradication of polio)

Providing clean water, sanitation, and hygiene

Supporting education

Saving mothers and children

Growing local economies

Protecting the environment

4. Programs and Initiatives:

PolioPlus: Rotary's flagship program aimed at eradicating polio worldwide. Rotary has been a key player in reducing polio cases by 99.9% since the initiative began in 1985.

Global Grants: Provide funding for large-scale international projects that align with Rotary's areas of focus.

Rotary Peace Centers: Support the education of peacebuilders through scholarships and academic fellowships.

5. Leadership: Rotary International is led by a President, elected annually, and governed by an international board of directors. The organization also includes District Governor who oversee regional clubs.

6. Membership: Rotary membership is open to individuals who hold leadership positions in their communities and are committed to community service. Membership offers opportunities for networking, personal development, and contributing to meaningful causes.

7. Motto: Rotary's motto is "Service Above Self," which encapsulates the organization's commitment to putting the needs of others first.

8. Theme 2024-2025- "The Magic of Rotary" is about celebrating the extraordinary impact that ordinary people can achieve when they come together with a shared purpose. Through its wide-ranging activities, Rotary International plays a vital role in addressing some of the world's most pressing challenges and fostering a spirit of global citizenship.
