

The St. Mary's Orthodex church known as 'Valiapally', is one among the churches believed to be established by Saint Thomas, the Apostle at the sleepy village of Niranam, when he visited the region during AD52. Rtn John Kurian, belonging to the successive generation of the set of people baptised by the St Thomas, is the 76th President of the

illutsrious RC Allepey. Kurian belongs to Kolathuvizhalil family and he is proud to share that for the Kudumbayogam of his family, there will be a gathering of not less than 2000 people.

Rtn John Kurian fondly called as Aniyan Kunju was born to late V M Kurian and late Mary Kurian. Late Kurian was working in the Iraq Military for long and he repatriated to India abruptly on hearing the news of the death by drowning of his 8 year old son. Later he joined a private bank at Madurai and finally came and settled at Alleppey by joining the Water Transport Department as Section Superintendent. John Kurian had his studies at St. Michel's School, Thathampally and the S D V High School, Alappuzha. He continued his studies through private regitsration. John Kurian lost his father in the year 1965 and the family decided to continue in Alleppey. Mr George Kurian, elder brother of Kurian, took him to Dubai and through his influence Kurian got selected in the Dubai Defense Services during the year 1980. Though Kurian joined the services in the etnry cadre, he later got promoted to the post of Stores-in-charge. In the year 2009 Aniyan Kunju got retirement from the Defense services and joined another private company engaged in the man power supply. And finally during the year 2014, he called it a day in Dubai after

completing 34 long years of service and repartiated to India. John Kurian is a good conversationalist and listener too. He maintains a unique qualtiy of winning over friends through his innocent talks in the family circles, church and other social groups. Kurian always tries to present a smart look by his appearance and also the upkeep of his car.

Kurian was inducted to RC Alleppey during the year 2016. Kurian with out wasting time became close to all the members of the club and their families too. During the year 2017-18, Kurian served as the Sergeant-at-Arms. He did wonderfully well in the post and won acclaims from all our members and even from the neighbouring clubs. In the succeeding year 2018-19 Kurian was elected as Joint Secretary and he became Acting Secretary during the last four months consequent to the sudden demise of then Secretary Rtn Moncy Varghese. Kurian became Secretary during 2019-20 and he performed well to the best of his abilities. During the year 2020-21, Kurian was elected to the post of Vice-President. In the succeeding year 2021-22, when the club management found it difficult to find a suitable person as Secretary, Kurian without any reluctance volunteered to become the Secretary for the second time in three years. Kurian gave full support to then President Varghese Kurisinkal and he was intsrumental in the tie-up with Joy Alukkas, Alappuzha for executing a few chartiy projects like financial aid to a cancer patient, contsruction of house for a poor family and ditsribution of dialys kits to kidney patients. These projects brought good PR to the club during the Covid-19 times. Considering his self-less services to the community and active participation in rotary matters, the club unanimously elected him as President for the year 2023-24. Destiny willed otherwise as Kurian had to undergo a surgeory and prolonged medical treatment and Kurian opted for 2024-25 as President. This year is more significant to RC Alleppey as the Platinum Jubilee year of the club. Kurian is married to Elsamma John, a pious lady always standing behind her husband. The Kurians have two daughters; elder one Mrs Sumi Nijo married to Rev. Fr. Nijo Pulikkottil in Trissur and they have a daughter Ria P Nijo, 1st year BSW student at St. Thomas College , Trissur. Mrs Sunu Chritsy is the second daughter married to Chritsy Thomas who has done Masters in Eletcronics and working as Relaionship Manager at Doha based Company. They have a daughter, one and half year old Misha Sara Chrity.


