

VENKY'S REMARKABLE JOURNEY

Rtn. R. Sreenivasan Rangamani—fondly known as Venky Swamy—was born in 1956 to Rtn. L. Rangamani, a distinguished Chartered Accountant and a stalwart in his profession. Though his father was a member of Rotary Club of Alleppey East, his heart was always with RC Alleppey, where he entrusted two of his finest legacies—his sons, Venky and Kitchappa—both of whom made significant contributions to the Rotary movement, particularly in RC Alleppey.Sadly, Venky's journey came to an abrupt end on 9th March 2025, leaving behind a legacy of dedication, service, and camaraderie.

A Life of Milestones

Venky had a sharp memory and an innate ability to recall details with precision. In a conversation a few years ago, when asked about his Rotary induction, he instantly replied, "30th April 1980." Indeed, 1980 was a landmark year for him—it was the year he qualified as a Chartered Accountant, joined his father's firm, Rangamani & Company, became a Rotarian, and married his beloved wife, Sobha. His entry into Rotary was serendipitous. When PP (Late) CA P.G. Panickar sought Venky's father's involvement in a fundraising project for the Platinum Jubilee Blood Bank, the senior Rangamani, citing health concerns, suggested that his son be inducted into RC Alleppey instead. That moment

marked the beginning of Venky's dynamic and dedicated journey in Rotary.

A Stalwart Rotarian

Venky's leadership shone brightly when he served as President of RC Alleppey in 1990-91. He took immense pride in the fact that, during his tenure, the club hosted an exclusive tea meeting attended by 10 Past District Governors (PDGs)—a rare privilege. Among the stalwarts present were PDGs Jambu Kesan, Peer Muhammed, Sundara Pandyan, Kadiresan, Jacob Thomas, A.I. Abraham, and RC Alleppey's own Revi Karunakaran. Another crowning moment of his presidency was welcoming Rtn. Rajendra Saboo, then RI President-Elect, to the club. A notable service project of his term was providing hand carts and cloth ironing machines to eight unemployed youths, a pioneering initiative in a time when finding skilled labor was a challenge. Under his leadership, club meetings saw maximum attendance, with meticulously planned events led by Club Service Director Jacob Neroth and Secretary Mohammed Sali.Beyond his presidency, Venky continued his active involvement in Rotary. He served as GGR (Governor's Group Representative) in 1995-96 and was a regular and generous contributor to The Rotary Foundation, surpassing USD 10,000 in donations and earning a place in the Major Donors Club in 2022-23. He was poised to celebrate 45 years in Rotary on 30th April 2025, but fate had other plans. A deeply passionate Rotarian, Venky often expressed concerns about the growing divisions and discord within the club, lamenting that such strife was detrimental to Rotary's mission and spirit. spirit.

Beyond Rotary

Venky's influence extended far beyond Rotary. He held several prestigious positions, including:

- 1. Treasurer, Southern India Regional Council of ICAI (1988-91)
- 2. Chairman, Travancore Chamber of Commerce (1987-88)
- 3. President, Ramavarma District Club, Alappuzha (2008-09)
- 4. Secretary, United Club (1993-94)

Venky was not just a professional and community leader; he was a devoted family man. His wife, Rtn. Ann Sobha, is a homemaker and an active member of the Inner Wheel Club of Alleppey. They built a beautiful family together: Arjun, their eldest son, is a VIT B.Tech (EC) graduate, settled in Houston, USA, with his wife and two children.

- · Ashwin, their second son, is a Chartered Accountant (CA) and CPA (Australia), serving as a partner at the Kochi office and working for Google, Hyderabad.
- Anju, their daughter, is a law graduate from Pune, settled in California, USA, with her husband, who also works for Google.

Venky's journey may have ended, but his legacy of service, generosity, and leadership will remain an inspiration for all who had the privilege of knowing him.

Rest in peace, Venky. You will be deeply missed but never forgotten.
