The air in Alleppey was thick with anticipation and pride as the legendary Rotary Club of Alleppey, a beacon of service for 75 glorious years, welcomed our District Governor Rtn. AKSM Sudhi Jabbar for the Governor's Official Visit (GOV) on 09.04.2025. The First Lady, Salma also joined the DG. The official visit commenced with a meticulously organized Club Assembly at 12:15 PM, hosted at the Hotel Classic Regency. Presided over by our dynamic President, Rtn. John Kurian, the assembly served as a platform for showcasing the club's unwavering commitment to the Rotary ideals. DG Sudhi reviewed the documents and records presented by the diligent Secretary, Rtn. Sujith TS, ensuring the club's adherence to protocols and standards. A poignant moment during the assembly was when DG Sudhi held the charter of the 75-year-old club in his hands. He eloquently expressed his privilege in holding such a significant piece of Rotary history, acknowledging the club's long-standing legacy of service and impact in the community. The DG then engaged in insightful discussions with the respective Directors, delving into the diverse array of activities undertaken by the club across various avenues of service. During the meeting DG addressed the gathering about the new Global Grant project launched by our Dist 3211, named: "Secured women – Secured family" for providing HPV vaccines to 10,000 girls aged between 9-14. The total project cost is USD 170,000/-. This project will be executed with the support of all the willing Clubs in our dist. Thankfully; Several Board Members demonstrated their characteristic generosity and commitment, contributions ranging from USD 500 to USD 100 towards this vital initiative. This immediate and heartfelt response deeply resonated with the DG. Special thanks to all those offered. I am sure that more members will come forward to support this project. Following a productive assembly that

concluded at 1:30 PM and a subsequent lunch, the DG and the board visited the Women and Children (W&C) Hospital, to visit the recently inaugurated "Nakshtra Vanam" under Planetree project, a testament to the club's environmental consciousness. He also visited the Blood Bank building donated by our Club. A detailed discussion ensued with the Hospital Superintendent Smt. Deepthy, Health Inspector Mr. Jayakrishnan, and other medical staff, providing the DG with a comprehensive understanding of the hospital's functioning and the crucial support extended by the Rotary Club of Alleppey. The next leg of the visit took the DG and the team to the Platinum Jubilee project site at Kattukada in Muhamma for the auspicious foundation stone laying ceremony of two new houses. The DG was visibly moved by his visit to the existing housing project, where three beneficiary families are living harmoniously, engaged in mutual cooperation and even agricultural activities at the premises. He expressed his happiness in laying the foundation stones for two more homes, further solidifying the club's commitment to providing shelter and dignity to those in need. In his address at the eve, he specifically highlighted the inspiring nature of the platinum jubilee housing project and the impactful work being done at the W&C Hospital. The afternoon's activities continued with a visit to Canoe Ville, the resort property of Rtn. Jijo, where the second "Nakshtra Vanam" project was to be installed. The team was warmly welcomed by Rt'Ann Megha, and in a symbolic gesture of environmental stewardship, the DG, First Lady, AG, the President, the Secretary and numerous club members joined in planting various trees associated with the Nakshtra Vanam concept. The day culminated in a heartwarming family dinner meet at the club, held in connection with the Governor's official visit. The event witnessed a remarkable turnout of members, Anns (spouses of Rotarians), and Annets (children of Rotarians), exceeding 110 + attendees. The meeting was a testament to the strong camaraderie and heritage of the Rotary Club of Alleppey, meticulously arranged to uphold its esteemed traditions. During the dinner meet, the club, with the generous support of its members, made a significant impact on the life of a young individual. An electric wheelchair, worth Rs. 60,000, was presented to Sreelakshmi, a 22-year-old girl suffering from muscular dystrophy whose education had been interrupted due to mobility challenges. It is hoped that this electric wheelchair will empower her to continue her education and explore opportunities for self-employment. Yet another humanitarian project, under a commendable CSR initiative facilitated through the contacts of club members, a brand new Maruti Eeco motor vehicle was donated to Marian Divyakarunyalayam, Muhamma, a rehabilitation center dedicated to the care and treatment of individuals with mental health challenges. This vehicle will significantly aid in the center's operations, facilitating the movement, treatment, and self-development of its residents. DG Sudhi Jabbar, in his address to the Club members, expressed his profound satisfaction with the Rotary Club of Alleppey's diverse activities, effective functioning, and the tangible impact of their projects. He conveyed his happiness in witnessing firsthand the dedication and passion of the club members and maintaining the Club legacy.
