ACQUIRING LIFE SAVING SKILLS

The Rotary Club of Residency recently conducted a comprehensive session on emergency care, first aid, and basic life support, led by the esteemed Dr. Shameem KU, MD, DNB, MRCEM Group Clinical & Academic Coordinator for the Department of Emergency Medicine at KIMSHEALTH Trivandrum.

Dr. Shameem an established leading authority in critical care was introduced by Rtn. Sreejith B

Singh as a researcher and academic, by contributing his valuable insights to the medical community through his publications and presentations. This enlightening program was aimed to equip club members with essential skills to handle critical situations, which enables them to provide timely and effective assistance. The Key Takeaways of the training are

- 1. Wound Management and Bandaging Techniques were demonstrated. Bandaging methods for different types of wounds, emphasizing the importance of proper wound care.
- 2. Seizure Management: Members learned how to identify and respond to seizures, including proper positioning and safety measures.
- 3. Techniques for controlling external bleeding, including the application of tourniquets and hemostatic agents.
- 4. CPR and CPR techniques were demonstrated by using mannequin highlighting the critical importance of timely intervention in the case of Cardiac Arrest.
- 5. Choking and Faint: Members learned how to recognize and respond to choking and syncope (fainting) incidents.



With a wealth of experience and advanced qualifications Dr. Shameem KU conducted the interactive session resoundingly successful, empowering Rotary Club of Trivandrum Residency members with essential emergency medical care skills. This session exemplified the Rotary values of Service Above Self by acquiring life-saving skills, members can serve their communities more effectively. The club extended heartfelt gratitude to Dr. Shameem for sharing his expertise in a very interesting manner.
