A TRIP DOWN THE MEMORY LANE

Our Charter member Rtn. RR Nair took us down the memory lane with his speech during our weekly meeting held on 12th July. Here are the major parts he covered during his talk

In 1985, RC Trivandrum South conducted a market survey establishing a scope for one more rotary club in Trivandrum. The club in turn approached the District Governor with the report and suggested the name of PP N.Krishnan kutty to be appointed as GSR and N GK Pillai as Charter President. After getting the necessary approval, they contacted and invited several citizens in the locality and conducted a series of meetings in different hotels and clubs. They were able to identify 25 probable members for a new club. The members were from different classifications as per RI regulations. GSR and his team got approval from other clubs who agreed to share their jurisdiction for a new club.

A statement with full details of probable members with all documents and RI fees were sent to RI. The GSR got approval and subsequently received the Charter certificate from RI.

We organized a charter nite the best way possible at Subramaniam Hall and Hon Kerala State Governor Viswanathan was the Chief Guest. It was a very well attended function on June 6th, 1986.

We, at RCTC, started our activities in 1985 onwards.

Major points include:

- 2. School water supply
- 3. RYLA
- 4. Active participation in all District activities.
- 5. Helping the old age home at Chackai on monthly basis, providing various facilities valued at Rs 90000 for the home and the chief guest was Hon Minister Smt Gouri Amma said now I understand that Rotary is doing good things for the society.



The year 1989-90 was a memorable one. Our club was awarded as the Best Star Club, our President was the Best President and our Secretary was the Best Secretary.
