PRESIDENTS' MESSAGE

'Nobody can ignore you without your consent'! Simply speaking, it is the power of one's emotions in managing the behaviour of others. In other words, ones' worth and attention is not depending on external validation. It serves as a reminder that you have the power to manage your emotional responses and maintain your self-worth regardless of how others treat you. That is, treatment of you is within your control.

This expression had been a food for thought for some time now. It was not just relevant to our club but the society as a whole. Is it not a trait of individual behaviour? Or could it be something one developed through one's social behaviour? Whatever it may be, but it is true to the core! You only are responsible for the treatment you receive!

These are common realities in every organisation that there are people or group of people who dominate the activities or decide the course of the activities. So naturally they also decide the individuals to be associated with or ignored. The ambitious ones who may not get inside may feel frustrated or irritated but others may ignore or dispel such deeds.

Consent can be voluntary or conditional, or both. It could be an agreement to participate in a specific activity. Can consent be emotional? If you give someone the chance to affect your feelings by ignoring you, you're giving away your emotional control. By not consenting to be affected, you maintain your emotional stability.

It is the practice in Rotary to appreciate and recognise the achievements and good work of the members or non-members. This happens often in meetings and even it becomes a part of the meeting routine. If you

are recognising the persons involved in an activity you are supposed to recognise everyone involved in it. Otherwise, the left-out persons may feel ignored. But if no one is appreciated or honoured why should someone feel ignored? If someone felt ignored in such a situation, can't one say that such a feeling is his own creation? In Rotary all are equal!

Keeping the mind free from small ambitions can relive us from big disappointments. Let us not allow someone to control our emotions.

MY VISION AS CLUB LEARNING-FACILITATOR

In this rotary year 2024-25, I am assigned as Rotary District PolioPlus adviser & Learning Facilitator for Rotary club of Kazhakuttom. There is no more teaching & training in rotary. All rotary members are learned, able to learn and able to teach others too. Each member shares one's wisdom, knowledge and skills with others. I shall work with other club leaders to create learning events and other programs that support our club members. I shall also work with district learning facilitator and assistant governor.

A leader should be a visionary, motivator, hard-worker, disciplined, good public speaker, listener, mentor, pro-active, coordinator, good time-manager etc. Discussion will provide members to share their leadership skills with others so that such skills in each of us are attained perfection. I have undergone RLI (rotary leadership institute) training Part I & Part II at Goa, and Rotary district 3211 facilitator's training program at Kollam. CROP (continuous rotary orientation program) is a designated program of our district, in accordance with RLI facilitation program, to be conducted at club level and/or zonal level.

In rotary, we conduct many projects including projects meant for the welfare of our members as well as others meant for social service. Such service projects may involve our club, zone, district, multi-districts or clubs in different countries (international projects). There may be participation of government departments/governmental and non-governmental institutions. Projects may be sponsored by foreign rotary club, non-rotary citizens, institutions, agencies, rotary district grants, rotary global grants from TRF

(The Rotary Foundation). Conduct of such service projects need feasibility survey, preparation of project proposal, sustainability, calculation of financial commitments, implementation, preparation of completion report, maintenance of continuity of the project, public involvement and income-expenditure statements. Our discussions will revolve round developing competency in each member, of conducting projects in rotary and in business and personal life. To make the group-learning a pleasant experience and at the same time a joyous outstation experience, we can arrange such programs at tourist-spots and eco-friendly venues.
