



Minutes of Director Board Meeting held on 7th Aug 2024

- •The Budget for the Rotary year 2024-25 were presented by the Treasurer. After a detailed discussion it was approved with the following changes.
 - a. Amount needs to be shown as donation from Rotarians and corresponding amount shown as expenses against service projects. This donation happens every year.
 - b. It was decided to allow the club hall to Rotarians for their personal/domestic functions after charging a nominal amount. An appropriate amount in this count should also be included in the Budget.
 - c. The following terms will apply for such allotment.
 - Rotarians and their families only could avail this facility.
 - 2. The rent will be Rs.2,000/-(Rupees two thousand only) for first two hours and Rs.500/- each for additional hours.
 - 3. Tips for the club boy should be paid separately.
 - 4. The decision of the Club President will be final in case of any dispute
- •The Income and expenditure accounts for the month of July, 2024 was

presented. It was also approved with the suggestion that an abridged version may be posted in the WhatsApp group of the Club.

- •The President explained about the proposed Focus project for distributing water bottles to students of schools where economically weaker students are enrolled. The bottles will be of good quality and the photos of the students will be printed in them. This project is likely to give good publicity to Rotary. The project is named 'Bottles of Hope'.
 - The President also informed about a project for recognizing the cooking staff of the Government schools. The idea is to provide a pair of aprons and caps which they can use while on duty. A suggestion to donate "Ona Kodi" to them was also accepted subject availability of sponsors.
 - The President also informed that in order to improve the image of Rotary the Rotarians should use, Rotary stickers in their houses and vehicles.
 - The meeting was adjourned by the President after vote of thanks.

The meeting was hosted by Rtn. Sheela Devi, who is the first lady Rotarian of the Club. She was very generous in arranging the dinner which was much-admired.


