
"Life Beyond Cancer" programme








AVOID THALASSEMIA BY GETTING YOUR BLOOD TESTED



How can a carrier pass on sickle cell disease to their child?



The chart shows that when two people who are both carriers have a baby together, there is a one in four (25%) chance that their baby may inherit sickle cell disease.

What does this mean for your family?

Your baby inherited their gene for sickle cell from either you or your partner. This means that one of you (or may be both of you) is also a healthy carrier.

- We recommend that both you and your partner find out if you are carriers. This is particularly
 important if you are thinking of having another baby. If both of you are carriers, there is a
 chance that you could pass on sickle cell disease to your next baby.
- It may also be a good idea to talk to other members of your family (such as your brothers and sisters, aunts, uncles and cousins) and encourage them to get a test before they start a family, in case they are carriers too. Showing them this leaflet may help. The test is a simple blood test and takes just a few minutes. To arrange the test, you can ask your GP.


