Thalassemia Awareness & Prevention Workshop

Subhojit Roy (RID 3291), delivered a compelling lecture that simplified complex medical information. The students engaged enthusiastically in the discussion, gaining vital knowledge about prevention and management.

Cleanliness and Environmental Awareness

Rtn. Nilanjan Sen addressed the assembly on the theme of Pariskar O Paricchanata (Cleanliness). His speech emphasized the dual importance of maintaining personal hygiene within the school premises and preserving the broader environment.

Menstrual Hygiene & Distribution

A senior lady teacher from the school led a sensitive and educational session on Menstrual Hygiene. To provide practical support, the Rotary Club of Budge Budge distributed sanitary napkins to all the girl students in attendance.

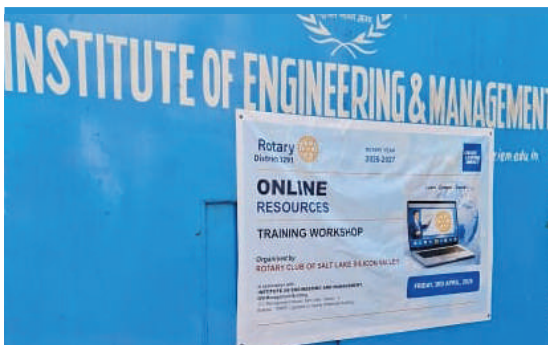
