- As per decision the Driver Training project under 'Self Employment' initiative to be started immediately. PP D K Mohta & Rtn Gouri Saha requested to take the initiative.
- A Pojector costing was asked to be taken by PP Nilanjan Sen to be given to a School as per the School's request.
- It was discussed that an initial enquiry to be taken from the District for any continuing or upcoming District grant or any other initiative Projects like Stitching Machine etc.
- It was decided that 'RC Budge Budge' will support the initiative of 'District Life Beyond Cancer' participation in the Event 'Mangalaya' on 6th – 7th Sep, 2025 for promotion of Products of the Cancer Survivors to make them self dependent & encourage their esteem positivity.
- PP Nilanjan conducted the Club Business & confirmed the next meeting date as 11th Sep, 2025 (Thursday).
- It was decided that as like previous year RCBB will go for the Project 'Sarad Sanman' whose detail planning is to be made in the next Meeting.
