FROM THE EDITOR'S DESK

Swami Vivekananda defined Hinduism as a universal and inclusive religion that emphasizes spiritual realization, the divinity of the soul, and the unity of all beings. He saw it as a way of life that transcends rituals, beliefs, and doctrines. According to Vivekananda, the essence of Hinduism is the realization of the oneness of the self (Atman) with the Supreme Reality (Brahman). He emphasized the importance of self-realization, meditation, and devotion to achieve a direct experience of this divinity. Vivekananda believed that Hinduism recognizes the divinity within every individual, and that each person has the potential to realize their own true nature. He often spoke of the idea of "Vedanta," which teaches that the ultimate goal of life is to realize that all is one and that there is no separation between the individual soul and the universal spirit. His teachings also highlighted the flexibility and adaptability of Hinduism, noting that it accommodates various paths to spiritual growth, such as the paths of knowledge (Jnana Yoga), devotion (Bhakti Yoga), and selfless action (Karma Yoga). Today, in the tumultuous time of war and conflicts, we may only hope that Swamiji's wordings and philosophy be the cornerstone of Rotary's global service projects under the aegis of 'peace and conflict management'.

Nature walk and birdwatching with school students



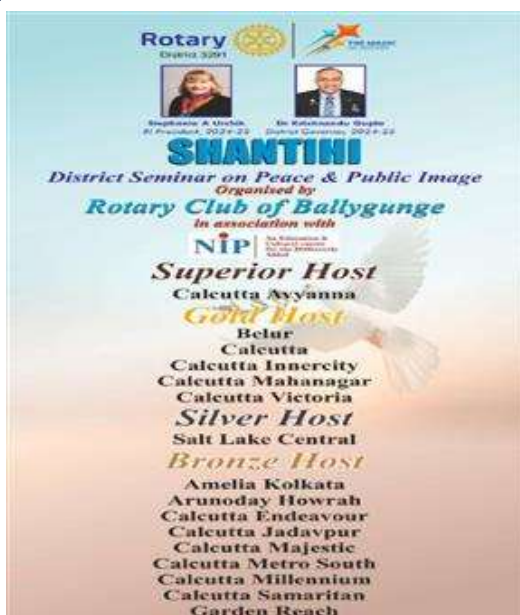

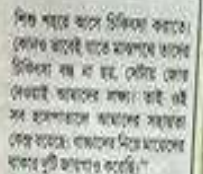
