Discussion Points:

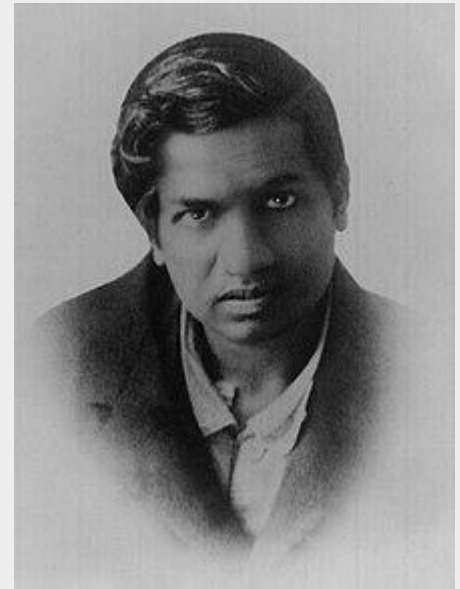
- The President called the meeting no.1703 to order and the National Anthem was led by Anne Moushumi.

The cheques were handed over by Rtn. Bhaskar.
- Thereafter, the President talked about the project at 'Social Welfare for the Blind' and their activities. He further apprised the members about donating the sewing machines to Nibedita Shishu Vihar.
- He further announced a project about donating 8 shawls and 1 cloth stretcher to Notun Ghar in December. The date is yet to be fixed.
- President announced the date for the project at Kultoli, where our Club would distribute textbooks to students of class 2.
- He further mentioned that on 21 December the Club picnic would be organised on a luxury boat leaving from Dhamakhali. Rtn. Prantik has taken the responsibility of the logistics. The transport to Dhamakhali has already been booked by Rtn. Rina.
- The president proudly informed the members about the appointment of Rtn. Deepak as the AG Administration (District) for the year 2025- 2026. The news was received with loud cheers and appreciation from the members. Rtn. Dipak's contribution to our club was unanimously lauded and appreciated by all members.

- The formation of RCC was discussed and Rtn. Swapan Bhaduri agreed to take the initiative. It was decided that a core committee would be formed to chalk out the plans and the sharing of responsibility among the members.
- The president informed the members that the junior school at Mahishbathan has approached our club for assistance for painting a classroom and for providing them with plastic chairs. The date of carrying out this project is yet to be discussed.
- Thereafter Rtn. Mala was asked to apprise the members about the progress of the fair 'Moner Taney'. She discussed the responsibilities of the members for the success of the fair, and discussed detailed plans. She emphasised on the importance of publicity and how all members can reach out to inform the public about the fair. She mentioned the estimated expenses and the amount already collected by way of donations. She congratulated Rtn. Ujjaini for being proactive in contacting people for renting stalls at the fair. She further requested the President to call a meeting before the 15th of December – the date of the fair – to discuss points for its final preparations.
- The president thanked her for her presentation. Club Secretary Kumkum thereafter announced the forthcoming birthdays and anniversaries of the members.
- After the conclusion of the meeting the President gave a very beautiful presentation on their trip to Kenya. Delicious snacks were served by Rtn. Indu and Rtn. Reshmi. On the occasion of this Bijoya and Diwali meet a grand dinner, entirely sponsored by Rtn. Mala, was served. They were profusely thanked by one and all.

Remembrance of scientific minds of India

Srinivasa Ramanujan (born on 1887–1920) was a brilliant Indian mathematician whose contributions to the field of mathematics continue to astonish scholars. Born in Erode, Tamil Nadu, he displayed extraordinary mathematical talent from a young age, excelling in **number theory, infinite series, and continued fractions** despite limited formal education. His groundbreaking work gained recognition when he sent a letter filled with mathematical formulas to the renowned British mathematician G. H. Hardy in 1913. Hardy invited Ramanujan to Cambridge, where their collaboration led to significant advancements in pure mathematics. Despite battling illness and cultural challenges, Ramanujan **produced over 3,000 theorems** during his short life, many of which remain influential. His profound intuition and unique approach have made him a legend, inspiring generations of mathematicians worldwide.


