Discussion Points:

- President Tapas called RWM NO 1709 to order.
- The National Anthem was led by the President.
- Important decisions regarding membership dues, fellowship and cost of the meeting venue was discussed, which are as follows:-
 - It has been decided that from the Rotary year 2025- 2026, the half yearly membership dues would be increased by Rs. 1000/-
 - Out of 24 Club meetings, 18 will be purely club meetings, where venue cost will be shared 50:50 between club members. The rest of the 6 meetings will coincide with fellowship program where the venue charge will be borne by the club only (in case it takes place at CF.

- Fellowship dinner expenses will be borne by respective Fellowship group members. Fellowship program expenses will be met by club fund.
- Fellowship Group members are supposed to take all decisions on Dinner/ snacks etc. and their decision would be final.
- Fellowship program will be decided and structured by Club service director only, where he/she can always discuss with other members to get their opinions.
- There will be no separate fellowship charge from now onwards.
- Fellowship program will generally take place at CF Community Hall. If the club meeting date coincides, the venue charge will be given by the club. In case, any such program is arranged at Anya Theatre, the charge will be borne by the club member which will be decided by the President.
- Fellowship program and club meeting date will be fixed on same day consciously.
- The President decided to merge the remaining fellowship fund and membership dues of this year. The president finalised this decision after it was agreed upon by the members present.
- The Holi meet has been fixed for 21 March at CF Community Hall.
- The President laid out his plans for the school at Mahishbathan after paying them a visit along with Rtn. Dipak, Shailen, Sharmila and Ujjaini. It was decided that the school desperately requires 3 fans for the class rooms. They have further requested our club to sponsor a meal for the children, which they couldn't provide on the day of the Saraswati Puja, due to lack of funds. The fans would be sponsored by the Club, and the meal most likely would be sponsored by our club members.
- It has been decided that on the 28th of February, a de humidifier, an air purifier sponsored by Rtn. Sharmila, and a wheel chair sponsored by Rtn. Mala would be handed over to Calcutta Heart Clinic.
- Next date of the meeting has been fixed on 7th Mar'25 at Rtn. Ujjayini's residence.

International Timeline

The international timeline is widely known, but let me tell you this: two islands, located just 3 miles apart, have a time difference of 21 hours. Can you believe that?

The two islands – **Big Diomede** (Tomorrow Island, Russia) and **Little Diomede** (Yesterday Island, USA) – are only about three miles (4.8 km) apart but lie on opposite sides of the International Date Line. Because of this, there is a 21-hour



time difference between them, meaning they are almost a full day apart!
