Discussion Points:

- PP Rtn Deepak Mitra called the meeting to order and Rtn Mala Chakraborty led the National Anthem
- Rtn Deepak Mitra informed that our guest Rtn Dr Payel Biswas had to leave on 6th Sep due to some urgent work. As such, she could not come to club today
- Rtn Deepak Mitra informed that our member Rtn Bhaskar Haldar has given his dues and also sent his resignation from club membership. It was discussed in the club and members opined that we should respect the Rtn Bhaskar Haldar's predicament that he is unable to contribute substantially in the club as he is staying overseas and there is no hope for him to finally come to Kolkata in the near future. Members hoped that we can approach him again after he finally settles down in Kolkata. However, the final decision would be taken after the President comes back from his tour.
- PP Rtn S.M.Chaki and PP Rtn Kalpana Roychowdhury desired that the Trust account of the club should be revived which is lying dormant for quite a few years. Rtn Chaki also informed that his donation of Rs. 1,00,000.00 is lying in

the account unutilised. It was decided that Rtn Chaki and Rtn Deepak Mitra would look into it. Also a new Committee would be formed and signatories changed in the bank account.

- Rtn Deepak Mitra informed that he, alongwith Rtn Reeta Bose, visited a Visually Challenged school in Salt Lake. They conduct various workshops to make the students self-dependent. They have requested for Rs 10,000.00 donation which may be given before the Pujas. President had agreed to donate Rs.5500.00 from club funds, while Rs.2500.00 has been donated by Rtn Tapas Bhattacharya and Rs 2500.00 will be donated by Rtn Debdip Dey.
- Rtn Deepak Mitra informed that he is very much interested to form an Interact Club due to which he approached Bhagabati Devi Balika Bidyalaya, AE Block, Salt Lake, for forming an Interact Club. Rtn Kum Kum Bose and other members had certain reservations about forming an Interact Club with that school since it will not give desired results as expected of an Interact Club. So it was decided that we look for a new school. Rtn Indumoti Choudhary proposed that she can approach Begum Rokaya School in this regard. It was unanimously supported and Rtn Indumoti has been requested to take necessary steps in this regard
- It was decided that members would go directly to Natun Ghar, Old age Home, to distribute the groceries and reach the venue by 11.00am on 9.9.23.
- Rtn Deepak Mitra informed that Rtn Reeta Bose has contributed Rs 3000.00 for utilising it towards Project expenses. All members thanked Rtn Reeta Bose for the wonderful gesture
- PP Rtn Kalpana Roychowdhury requested that club should take action to possess a Pan card of its own. It was decided that necessary steps would be taken in this regard
- Rtn Deepak Mitra requested everyone to attend the family gettogether/Nirbhejal Adda/Monsoon Snacks Party at Rtn Kum Kum Bose's residence on 17.9.23 and reach the venue by 6pm
- Rtn Deepak Mitra informed that he had visited Gandhi Seba Sadan & School near Daffodils, Lake town, and found that there is scope to do some projects

there. He requested that some members may visit their office and explore what projects can be done

- Rtn Deepak Mitra requested PP Rtn S.M.Chaki that we can plan to organise Prakritir Haat in his premises to which he agreed. It was decided that it can be organised in December or January
- Rtn Deepak Mitra informed that he visited Nawabpur Prathamik Vidyalaya and was quite impressed with programs organised by the school students and their performances. He proposed that some members should have a meeting with Mahishbatan Jatiya Pathshala and guide them as to what are our expectations projects from their school and what would we like the students to do. Also advance planning has to be done for 26th January. Members were not very satisfied as to the way the program was organised on 15th August.
- The project/trip to Sunderbans was discussed in detail and it was decided that it would be a one day trip. The Boat/Launch would be organised by Club Secretary Rtn Prantick Roychowdhury and the project would be planned by Rtn Itu Upadhyay and Rtn Mala Chakraborty. All members were requested to participate with family. It may be organised in the first Sunday of December
- It was decided that a Picnic would be organised in Taki in the 1st week of February. Everything should be finalised by November end.
- On the occasion of 'World Alzheimer's Day on 21.9.23, Thursday, Rotary Club of Salt Lake Central, alongwith other clubs, is organising a Seminar wherein eminent doctors will speak. All members were requested to attend the Seminar at Prakash Bhavan on 21.9.23, Thursday, at 6.00pm..




