Project

Joygopalpur Primary School at Sundarbans - 2Dec23

On December 02, 2023, Rotary Club of Salt Lake Downtown (RCSLDT) completed a wonderful project at Joygopalur School at Sunderbans. Rtn. Sailen Dewan and Rtn. Deepak Mitra ideated and executed this project with



excellence. 15 strong and enthusiastic club members along with their families attended this day trip at Sundarbans.

The first leg of the journey by bus started at 7AM from Kolkata and we all had sumptuous breakfast prepared by Rotarian Itu and Anne Tanushree on

our way to Dhamakhali Ferry ghat which is at a distance of 70 Kms from Kolkata.

The second leg was by motor boat to cross the river to reach Tushakhali ferry ghat. The river cruise was quite exciting.

The third leg of our journey started from Tushakhali Ferry Ghat by 2 cars to travel roughly 12 Kms of bumpy stretch, deep inside Sunderbans area, to reach Joygopalpur Primary School, the actual project site at about 12PM in the afternoon.

Joygopalpur Primary School (up to Class V) caters to a large area in the region and around 95 (ninety five) children (boys and girls) from nearby villages come to this school to get their basic education. Needless to mention that majority of those students come from very poor background and usually suffer from malnutrition. This school runs with three teachers only and very poor infrastructure facilities.

RCSLDT with an aim to develop the basic facilities of the school, donated 5 (five) Ceiling Fans to be used during summer season and 15 (fifteen) large floor mats for the students. Besides this, a set of Pencil, Pen, Eraser, Sharpener and Chocolate bar (one piece each) was distributed amongst students. It was an immense pleasure for every member of the team while noticing the joy and happiness on the innocent faces of those little kids.

While returning, at Sandeshkhali, full course lunch was arranged which was nothing but a gastronomic delight. After lunch, we embarked on a pleasurable boat cruise over Bidyadhori and Raymongal rivers and enjoyed a beautiful sunset at the backdrop of mangrove forest. It was an excellent cruise for almost an hour which was worth remembering.

From the Ferry Ghat, the bus started at about 5-30PM in the evening and finally brought us back to Kolkata at 8-30PM.

The Project in Sunderban was indeed a meaningful project and many such project should be continued in a sustainable fashion to have a significant impact on the overall development of the marginalized rural population.
