## MINUTES OF DISTRICT GOVERNOR ASSEMBLY ALONG WITH 372ND RWM OF ROTARY CLUB OF CALCUTTA MAJESTIC HELD AT INTERNATIONAL CLUB ON 11TH NOVEMBER '25

- President Kanta SenGupta called the 372nd RWM to order.
- She invited District Governor Rtn Dr Ramendu Homchoudhuri and Assistant Governor Rtn Amit Sen to the Head Table.
- The National Anthem was led by First Lady Rtn Dr Bandana Homchoudhuri.
- Our Club welcomed District Governor Rtn Dr Homchoudhuri, First Lady along with District officials.
- President Kanta Sengupta briefed about Projects done from July till October.
- President announced the Upcoming projects.
- Club Secretary Simmi Barua transacted the Club business.
- She mentioned that the District Program is on 9th, 10th and 11th January. We have the District Conference at The East Pavillion, Nicco Park. The registration cost for the same is Rs 3000/- till 15th December, post this date the registration cost becomes Rs 4000/-. Members are requested to join, especially the new members.
- On 13th December, a District Program is being hosted for the Incoming President at Saturday Club for the Meet and Greet. The incoming President for year 2025-26 needs to attend this programme.

Now there are 132 toilets in this village along with electricity, majority created by Rotary.
- Foundation Seminar will be held on 27th November at Spring Club, EM Bypass, where Leander Paez is the Chief guest. Members are requested to attend. The money collected from here will be put in the Foundation Fund.
- 6th December is the President- Secretary meet, further details to be given.
- 9th, 10th and 11th of January is the Conference. On 9th January is the GGLD and COL election.
- President has been requested to complete all formalities regarding the RI dues, election formalities for voting rights.
- Paul Harris badge is a prestigious badge which can be achieved by giving \$1000. One can get this by giving \$500 while the remaining amount will be given by the District. By 27th November, if \$400 is paid, then also this badge can be owned.
