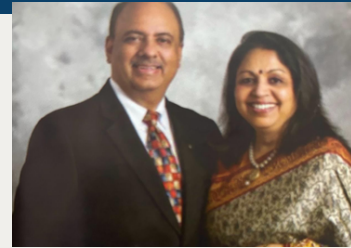

# Projects in January & February

RCCD through RCC Bani Mandir , 24 Pgs (S), has donated 15 small Poultry farms along with chicks among 15 unemployed women for their financial and nutritional support. 5 days training was given to them and material for making poultry cage was also provided. 12 Chicks and medicine for looking after chicks were given to each women.

Total number of beneficiaries including family are 75.

Total Project cost was Rs. 1,30,000/-



RCCD conducted educational cum fun trip to Alipore zoo on 11th January under Eazy School 2 for students of BaghBazar Sarada Vidyalaya school, a school for street children of Baghbazar area. Students throughly enjoyed the tour and gathered knowledge from teachers and Rotarians.

Total number of beneficiaries were 60.

Total Project cost was Rs. 20,000/-



RCCD distributed Personal Hygiene Kit i.e. tooth paste, toothbrush & soap to the students of Baghbazar Sarada Prathamik vidyalaya. It was also explained how good personal hygiene is one of the best ways to protect themselves from getting infectious diseases such as colds and flu.

Total number of beneficiaries were 75. Total project cost was Rs. 2500/-



Blankets were distributed among underprivileged sections of community on 1st January at Tiljala and on 13th January at Mathsheyalli village, Hooghly.

Total number of beneficiaries were 115. Total cost of 2 projects : Rs. 18,400/-
