PROJECT SAVE A LIFE -1

Saving the life of a child has always been a priority of the club. We started this project in 2010 with saving the life of 3 children. We have collaborated with Narayana RN Tagore Hospital and our first effort this year began on 2nd July 2024. This year club has a goal of doing at least 6 pediatric heart surgeries. Like last year, the club started the Doctors month i.e. Month of July as well as the Rotary year 2024-25 with the noble project of Paediatric Heart surgery and saved precious life of one small child who was suffering from a congenital heart disease. Unless treated early, the child would have died. The Open Heart surgery was done at Narayana Hrudalaya (earlier R N Tagore Hospital) on 02.07..2024 at a cost of Rs.4.00 lacs appx. The child belonged to Ranchi district of Jharkhand. Apart from saving life, the beauty of this treatment is that the child will not require any further medication after six months from the date of operation.



PROJECT UNDER DISTRICT EAZY SCHOOL 3 SIT & DRAW COMPETITION

The first Sit and Draw competition was organised at a village Udaipur near Jaynagar which is at least 4 hours journey from Salt lake at the South 24 parganas. A RCC has already been proposed and applied to RI for that village. Around 60 children participated in the contest. They were all budding artists. May be some day we may use their artwork for beautiful posters and cards. It is a remote village and lots to be done. The club has plans to do more work at the village Udaipur



A HANDS- ON WORKSHOP ON NAVIGATING ATTENTION DEFICIT CHALLENGES FOR SUCCESS

The workshop was held at **Rotary Sadan** on **24th July**. This was a joint project with **Rotary Club of Calcutta** It was conducted by **Centre for Cognitive Emotional Empowerment**. This centre is the initiative of PP Samir Saha who has been researching on child development for the last few years. The workshop was attended by 102 students of class VIII to XII of 12 reputed schools of Kolkata. Rtn Samir was supported by Sudeshna Majumdar who is a qualified psychological counsellor and is a part of the Centre's Counsellor panel. MEGA HEALTH CHECK UP CAMP

This was the consecutive second year that our club did the **Mega Health Check up camp**. We organised the camp at Dishari Banquest Hall in Salt lake on 28th July. It was a Joint project with RC Saltlake Metropolitan and co hosted by 12 Rotary clubs and 1 Inner wheel club.

Around **90 beneficiaries** got their tests done. There was complete blood checkup by DR Lal Path. Anemia test and guidance by Matri Raksha team lead by Rtn Dr Aruna Tantia. There was an eye check up team and provision of spectacles free cataract operation. A team of nutritionist and dietician were there for providing the proper diet and exercise. In all, it was an all round camp. The project was attended by DGN Tapas Bhattacharya, PDG Raju Rajgaria, PDG Rajani Mukherjee and PDG Prabir Chatterjee. All cohost club representatives also participated.

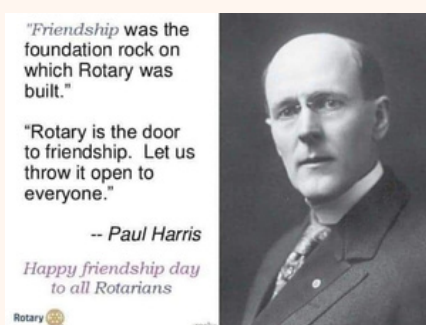
